



Policy Deficit in Open Sea Mariculture in India

He observes that, under the leadership of the Union Fisheries Division, the various maritime States have to undertake follow-up work in respect of installation of cages all along the coastline, adding that this involves allotment of sites at sea for cage installation, and organising the fabrication of cages and their supply to the stakeholders, to be selected through needed publicity among the stakeholders. It is obvious that the suggestions of the author require immediate attention/follow-up action by the centre and the coastal States as needed 30



