

KAI BAHLMANN

Born on January 29, 1927, in Düsseldorf, Germany.

Was in military service and prisoner of war from 1944 to 1946. From 1947 to 1951, studied law in Cologne, Bonn, and Freiburg, passing first State Legal Examination in Cologne in 1952. Gerichtsreferendar (junior barrister), Superior Regional Court, Cologne, from 1952 to 1956. Passed second State Legal Examination in Düsseldorf in 1956, and became Gerichtsassessor (barrister), Superior Regional Court, Cologne, in 1956.

From September 1958 to September 1960, attached as expert to the Federal Constitutional Court. In 1959, became Counsellor, Regional Court in Cologne.

Since 1961, has been in the Federal Ministry of Justice, Department IV—Public Law. In June 1969, became head of Department IV—Public Law (constitutional law, international law, Community law, legal examination of draft laws and regulations).

Appointed Judge at the Court of Justice on October 7, 1982.
