






# Vale - BARRY BARNES

### **Barry Edward Barnes**

Barry joined our Society in 2006. In his quiet, understated way he was always willing to contribute to the organisation and running of the Club. Barry would help where he was physically able and in fact was appointed to the management committee to manage the orchid naming, a very important and complex task which he did with dedication and accuracy until his forced retirement at the beginning of 2017.

Barry commenced the Orchid Council Judging course in 2011 to further advance his interest and knowledge in Orchid culture. He was a keen student and successfully completed the course and became a fully accredited Orchid judge in 2016. Because of his gentle nature Barry was often reticent in giving negative assessments of a particular plant, however any opinions he did give were always accurate but considerate of the growers feelings. Barry's passion for growing orchids led to him accumulating a collection of high quality plants. He had a particular expertise in producing excellent Dendrobium specimens. He was the recipient of many major prizes at regional orchid shows, including Champion Orchid of Show. Listed below are his Australian Orchid Council awards – a wonderful achievement for such a short time.
