










































































































The ribs

- 11-12 are floating ribs



























Hand

- Carpals = wrist bones
- Metacarpals = palm bones
- Phalanges = digits (fingers)
 - Pollex (thumb) has 2 phalanges, other fingers have 3 phalanges
 - Labeled proximal, medial, & distal
 Which is missing in the thumb?
- Bones are <u>numbered</u> from the thumb (first) towards the pinky finger (fifth)
