
1. Set up and connect your printer (Mac OS X)

Network connection (Bonjour/Rendezvous).

1. Make sure that the printer is turned on and connected to a functioning Ethernet network, and that all of the computers in the network are turned on and connected (including hubs and routers).

2. On the printer's front panel, select the icon, select **Connectivity**, **Gigabit Ethernet**, and then select **View configuration**. Note the mDNS service name that appears on the front panel.

3. Insert the HP Start-Up Kit CD/DVD into your CD/DVD drive, double-click the CD/DVD icon on your screen, and then look for the 'Mac OS X HP Designjet Installer' icon.



4. Double-click the appropriate icon to launch the installer, and then follow the on-screen instructions. Note: HP recommends that you use the **Easy Install** option.




