Ciarán Madden Consul General of Ireland



Ciarán Madden began his career at the Department of Foreign Affairs began in November 1994. His early career with the Department included various roles in the Department in Dublin from; at Ireland's Permanent Representation of Ireland to the European Union, and as Advisor to the Oireachtas Joint Committee on European Affairs, 2002 – 2003.

From 2003 - 2005 he was assigned as the Press Officer for the Department and following this he spent a year in the Department's Development and Co-operation Division. During his time here he co-drafted the White Paper on Irish Aid. Ciarán also served as Private Secretary to the Minister for Foreign Affairs before moving on to become the Head of Finance and Planning from 2007 to 2009.

Ciarán served for four years as Ambassador of Ireland to the United Arab Emirates (also accredited to Qatar and Kuwait), from 2009 to 2013. Upon his return to Dublin, he was appointed Director for the Irish Abroad Unit in September 2013, and led the drafting of The Global Irish – Ireland's Diaspora Policy. Following this role, Ciarán was appointed Director for the Middle East and North Africa in January 2015. He took up duty as Consul General of Ireland in New York in August 2017

Ciarán, a native of County Cork, is married to Lana Fitzsimons and they have one daughter, Ruby.

Ambassador Award

The Ambassador Award, named in honor of the Ambassador of Ireland to the United States, is presented annually to honor a company that has furthered the goals of the Irish American Business Chamber by developing business between the Isle of Ireland and the United States. Daniel Mulhall is the current Ambassador of Ireland to the United States.

Adapt Pharma

Accepting on behalf of Adapt Pharma: Eunan Maguire, Chief Operating Officer



Adapt Pharma was founded in Ireland in 2013 and is proud to call Pennsylvania its U.S. home, with operations based in Radnor, PA. Adapt developed and distributes Narcan (naloxone) Nasal Spray – the leading FDA approved community use emergency treatment for reversal of known or suspected opioid

overdoses. As it continues to meet the public health goal of expanding access to Narcan Nasal Spray throughout North America, it is also developing new treatment options for those with opioid addiction.

North America is in the midst of an unprecedented opioid overdose epidemic. This human tragedy is claiming almost 100 lives each day in communities throughout the nation - more than gun related deaths and traffic accidents. Adapt works alongside multiple stakeholders who are collaborating to respond to this crisis.

As most opioid overdoses happen in homes and communities outside the immediate reach of professional medical assistance, Narcan Nasal Spray was designed to allow non-medically trained people, like parents, siblings and friends, to rapidly treat a person experiencing an opioid overdose until professional help, which should always be sought, arrives.

Adapt has also pioneered a novel affordable pricing approach to make this potentially lifesaving medicine available at a deep discount to all first responders, law enforcement, community outreach groups and governmental entities. For individuals, this approach has achieved almost universal insurance coverage at affordable co-pays. Adapt also supports education about opioid risks and offers a free Narcan Nasal Spray to high schools and universities throughout the United States.



Caoiseach Award

The Taoiseach Award is presented to an Irish Chamber member of Irish descent who has, by example, shown exceptional business leadership and compassion. The Taoiseach Award takes its name from the original Irish title meaning Chieftain or Leader. Today, An Taoiseach is the Prime Minister of Ireland, Leo Varadkar, T.D.

Jerry J. Maginnis Managing Partner, KPMG (Retired)



Jerry spent 36 years with the Philadelphia offices of KPMG, a global network of professional firms providing Audit, Tax and Advisory services, retiring on September 30, 2015. He served as the Managing Partner of the firm's Philadelphia office from 2006 through 2015. Previously, he spent five years as the Partner in Charge of the firm's Audit practice in Pennsylvania, overseeing operations in KPMG's Philadelphia, Harrisburg and Pittsburgh offices. Jerry is a Certified Public Accountant and a graduate of Saint Joseph's University.

Since retiring from KPMG, Jerry has joined the Board of Cohen & Steers Mutual Funds based in New York City. Cohen & Steers is a global investment manager specializing in liquid real assets. The twenty-two funds' assets under management were estimated at \$32 billion as of October 31, 2017. He is also a Board Member of the Faith in the Future Foundation and the Foundations of both the American and Pennsylvania Institutes of Certified Public Accountants. Jerry continues to serve on the Pennsylvania Early Learning Investment Commission and as an Executive in Residence at Rowan University in Southern New Jersey where he chairs the University's Accounting Advisory Board.

Previously, Jerry served as the President of the 22,000 member Pennsylvania Institute of Certified Public Accountants (PICPA), a member of the Board and Executive Committee of the Greater Philadelphia Chamber of Commerce, a member of the CEO Council for Growth, a member of the Board of Trustees of Gwynedd-Mercy University and Saint Joseph's Preparatory School, and on the Boards of the Historical Society of Pennsylvania and The Union League of Philadelphia.

Jerry was awarded the Father of the Year award from the Philadelphia Chapter of the American Diabetes Association in 2009. In 2011, he received the Distinguished Public Service Award from the PICPA as well as the Breath of Life award from the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation. In 2015, he received the Heart of Philadelphia award from the American Heart Association and the Medal of Excellence award from Rowan University's Rohrer College of Business in 2017.

Uachtarán Award

The Uachtarán Award is named in honor of the President of Ireland, or Uachtarán na hEireann, in Irish. In the 1990s, Mary Robinson, the seventh President of Ireland, transformed the role of the President by developing a new sense of Ireland's economic, political, and cultural links with other countries and cultures, especially those of the Irish Diaspora. Michael Higgins, the ninth and current President of Ireland and the former Minister for arts, culture, and the Gaeltacht in the 1990s, has excelled in this cultural and economic "building bridges" role.

H. Edward Hanway is the former Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Cigna Corporation and now serves as the non-executive Chairman of Marsh & McLennan Companies, Inc. He currently serves as the Chairman of Faith in the Future, an independent foundation that provides strategic management and operational oversight of 17 high schools and four schools of special education in the Archdiocese of Philadelphia and provides support services to all Archdiocesan schools in the five county Philadelphia area.

Through the years, Mr. Hanway has been active in a wide range of issues and initiatives associated with children's health, education and international business. He serves as Chairman of Drexel Neumann Academy and is a board member of the Crozier – Keystone Community Foundation. He is a former board member of The Philadelphia Orchestra, and was a member of The Business Roundtable and the Eisenhower Exchange.

A member of the Pennsylvania and American Institutes of Certified Public Accountants, Mr. Hanway earned his B.A. from Loyola University of Maryland and his M.B.A. from Widener University.

Ellen M. Hanway embodies the principles and values of a Catholic education. Mrs. Hanway attended Nativity BVM Parish School and Notre Dame High School before graduating from the Keystone School of Business.
