When all forms have been completed, please return them to the Circuit Civil/Family Law Department of the Jackson County Clerk of Court, along with your filing fee of \$300.00. Your case will be forwarded to the Family Court Specialist for review. You may check back with a Deputy Clerk in 2 to 3 weeks for the status of your case.

This petition and other documents must be served on the other party. <u>DO</u> <u>NOT</u> have the other party served until you have received approval of your petition from the Family Court Specialist. If you allege in the petition that paternity has already been established, as a matter of law, you must include a certified copy of the final order of paternity when you file your paperwork.
