Jaipur Municipal Corporation (JMC) tabled the budget for financial year 2016-17 in the general body meeting (GBM) on 12 February,2016. A budget of Rs 1,350 crore tabled for 2016-17, Rs 100 crore more than the previous financial year.

Since Jaipur has been included as part of the Centre's smart city mission, Rs 50 crore has been provided for that purpose in this budget. "JMC has to deposit its share to the state government for developing Jaipur as smart city. We have created a provision in our budget for that," said a finance committee member.

In the previous year, JMC proposed to spend Rs 483 crore for various development works.

For the first time, however, provision of Rs 5 crore has been made for construction of rainwater harvesting structures. Rs 2 crore has been allocated for providing facilities to slum dwellers.

This financial year, JMC hopes to earn revenue of Rs 100 crore from door-to-door garbage collection.

This time, JMC has also increased the target of collecting urban development (UD) tax. "Last year, the JMC target for UD tax was Rs 150 crore. This year it has been increased to Rs 180 crore."








Stop Over

Albert Hall Museum is a museum in Jaipur city in Rajasthan state of India. It is the oldest museum of the state and functions as the State museum of Rajasthan. The building is situated in Ram Niwas Garden outside the city wall opposite New gate and is a fine example of Indo-Saracenic architecture. The building was designed by Sir Samuel Swinton Jacob, assisted by Mir Tujumool Hoosein, and was opened as public museum in 1887. It is also called the Government Central Museum. Maharaja Ram Singh initially wanted this building to be a town hall, but his successor, Madho Singh II, decided it should be a museum for the art of Jaipur and included as part of the new Ram Nivas Garden. The museum has a rich collection of artefacts like paintings, carpets, ivory, stone, metal sculptures, colourful crystal works etc.
