"Opener Trivia"

From the last issue Art Santen corrected me on page 15 K-4-2 Falstaff is K-2-2 and on page 17 the K-4 pictures are reversed. Thanks Art for spotting these corrections. Art also sent in pictures of his "K" collections and with his help I was able to add colors to all of the "K" listings where appropriate and to make some corrections (see the 1998 additions and corrections in this issue).

Eldon Gregg did respond to my question about the new discovery Jax Beer Donkey (A-61). There is some question as to whether the A-61 was produced by a brewery. Eldon's response was the same one that I give new members when they ask about an opener they want to list in the handbook. If Jax Beer paid to print Jax Beer on the opener it is authentic and if they did not then it is not authentic. Eldon works for an engraving company and he says they only engrave company names if that company requests it. They do not engrave company names for individuals. I know individuals who have had metal openers engraved must pay handsomely because a diamond-tipped bit is required. If an individual engraved the A-61 it was done some time ago as the opener has experienced some wear. Since Jax beer was made in Jacksonville Florida (I assume due to space Jacksonville was shortened to Jackson on the opener) that this opener was produced by the brewery. Maybe a big assumption on my part but if I was going to engrave an opener I would almost assuredly engrave it with Budweiser and not some small southern brewery.

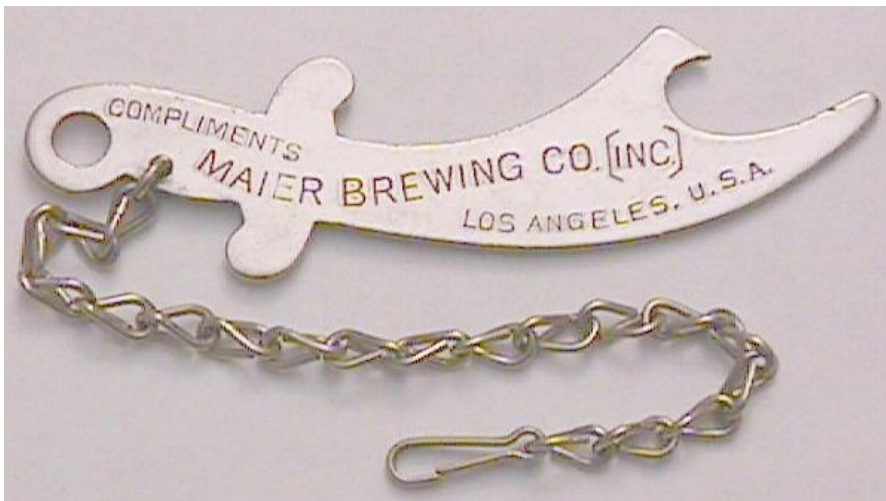
Pictured below are two nice finds made by Lou Sutton of Virginia. The one on the left is a P-88-UL Virginia Brewing Co. Lou found it at a Richmond antique show after all of the pickers had been through. Any twisted wire other than the P-1 Anheuser-Busch is tough to find. On the right is the bottom of an L-2. A great piece of saloon advertising and a tie-in with elephants also. The plate is stamped "White Elephant Saloon (Pic of an Elephant) Keystone, W.Va. Most anything pre-pro from West Virginia is hard to come by.

Just above the L-2 is a "Sterling" Whale opener from the 1934 Chicago World's Fair. This originally was in Don Bull's collection and now I can say that I am the proud owner. Just about any sterling opener is a good find.

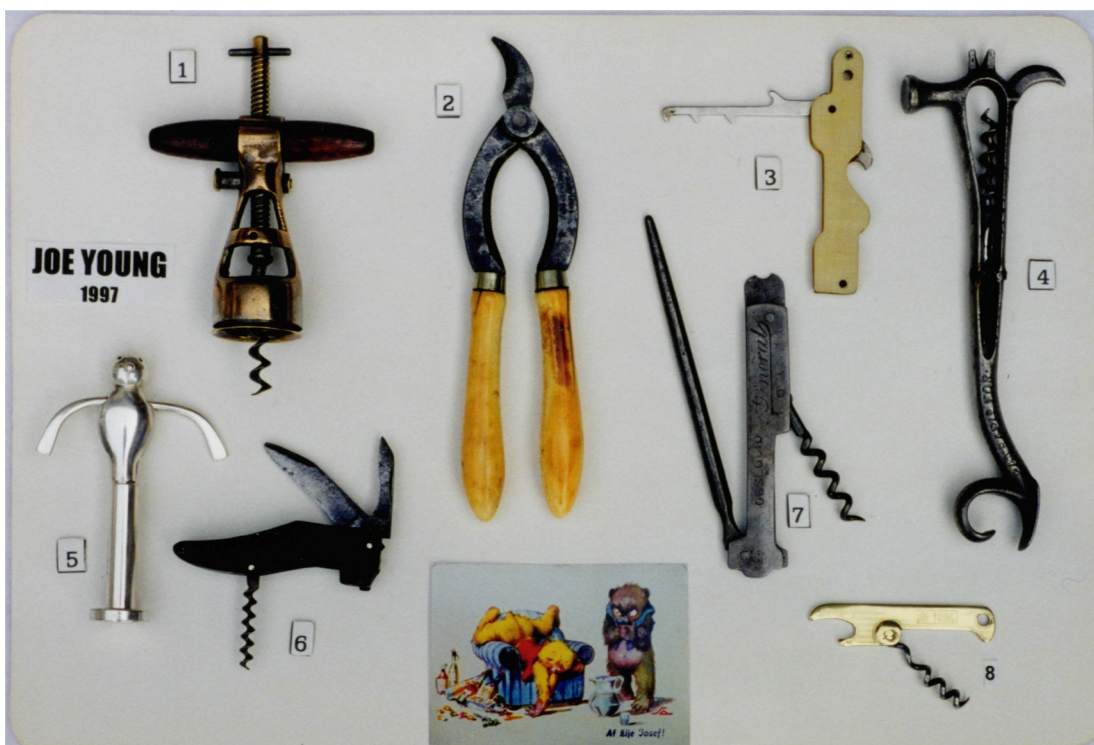


“Opener Trivia” (Continued)

The A-12 shown below answers a question I have had for a couple of years. Two A-12s that were sold through the JFO auction had a small hole beside the key ring hole. I assumed someone had drilled the hole but also wondered if it had a purpose. I bought the A-12-2 Maier in mint condition and it has a key chain attached to the opener. Now I know what the little hole is really for. To the right is a German opener that I think is real neat. It is bottle shaped and has an opener blade (only). I would date from somewhere in the 30s to 50s time range.



Finally I wanted to include Joe Young’s “Best 6 +3 Corkscrews for 1997”. It is very amazing in this day and age to find one undiscovered opener or corkscrew. To find 9 in one year is just unbelievable. But good things happen to good people such as Joe and Jackie Young. Continued success in 1998 for you two and all JFO members. BEST 6 + 3 FOR 1997

In Memory of and as a tribute to the tireless research spirit of Bob Nugent, our beloved friend, we present this years' best six plus three.

*I believe that **all** of the corkscrews pictured in this year's selection are **new discoveries** or at least haven't been presented in previous Best sixes except one (No. 6). Five of the seven American pieces were patented. Two may have as yet undiscovered design patents and one is simply nifty.*

1. We are very pleased to be able to present this corkscrew this year. It is **David McBain Syme's US patent No. 1,012,931, patented on December 26, 1911.** Syme states in his patent "that it relates to improvements in corkscrews and the object is to provide a simple and effective construction of a corkscrew by means of which a cork, no matter how tightly fixed in the bottle-neck may be easily and readily drawn without chipping, cracking or breaking the bottle." Apparently born out of his own frustration.

One would have to be familiar with the entire patent to be able to appreciate all of the built-in mechanisms. The piece is even more intriguing than it looks. (A personal demonstration would be helpful) In our opinion a most ingenious corkscrew.

There is a relatively small, tapered wooden handle. The cage is made of nickel plated brass. It is unmarked, however it fits the patent drawing almost to a "T". It is very well constructed.

We were fortunate to talk with David Syme's sole surviving daughter. In talking with her she was surprised that we had located her father's corkscrew. Her family doesn't have one and she is unaware that any others exist. As she remembers very few were made. He simply lacked the finances to mass-produce it. She also vividly remembers her father using his corkscrew to open bottles of wine at the dinner table on Sundays.

David McBain Syme was born in 1880. He was of Scottish decent and resided in Newport, Rhode Island. He had a fine reputation as a machinist with an inventive turn of mind and he was the originator of several mechanical devices besides his corkscrew. He was thirty-one years old when his corkscrew was patented.

Syme initially worked at the **Torpedo Station** on Goat Island in Newport, RI -- which was the **birthplace of the modern torpedo.** He then went into business for himself and later on returned to work at the torpedo station.

During **WWI** he helped in the development of a **gyroscope** which was used to obtain a more accurate trajectory when launching torpedoes. He also developed a **hydrocarbon (oil) burner** for heating buildings. One was installed in the City Hall in Newport.

Syme also invented a **can opener.** It was a can punch and can sealer.

David McBain Syme died on January 29, 1937, at his home following a stroke that occurred one week earlier. He was only 57 years old. It is our good fortune that his corkscrew survives.

2. An example of **John T. Haviland's** (of San Francisco, California) American patent for a corkscrew **No. 104,453 patented June 21, 1870.** The handles are made of walrus tusk. In essence, the piece is not a corkscrew but a champagne cork remover and wire breaker. The jaws are made of high quality steel and marked **J. T. Haviland.** Pat. Applied for. The patent drawing shows a brush in place at the end of one of the handles. This production piece does not come with a brush in either handle.

3. This piece is similar in mechanism to another American two finger puller, marked E-Z Puller, pat. pending. This puller folds into the piece. There is also a bottle opener. The scales (sides) are made of laminated **Formica.** The first time that we have seen an extractor or corkscrew made with **Formica.** The silhouette of this piece lends itself to some interesting speculation.

4. Another American piece. **Benjamin N. Shelley's** (of Anderson, Indiana) improvement in combination tools. Patented **Sept. 2, 1879. Pat. No. 219,313**. In order to attract a larger market he named it the **Ladies' Friend**. It is also marked Pat. Apld. For. The patent states "My invention consists of a combined implement for domestic and other purposes which present in a simple device and compact form the functions of a

14 functions in all - almost a record. The final production piece, however, doesn't include all of the above mentioned functions.

5. An upright free standing **silver-plated penguin** figural corkscrew which is seated in it's own stand. The bottom of the stand is marked Napier. (American). Measures 4 1/8 inches. Another American figural corkscrew in the shape of a penguin was patented by Kurt Rettich (Toledo, Ohio). His design patent D-89,308 was issued on February 21, 1933.

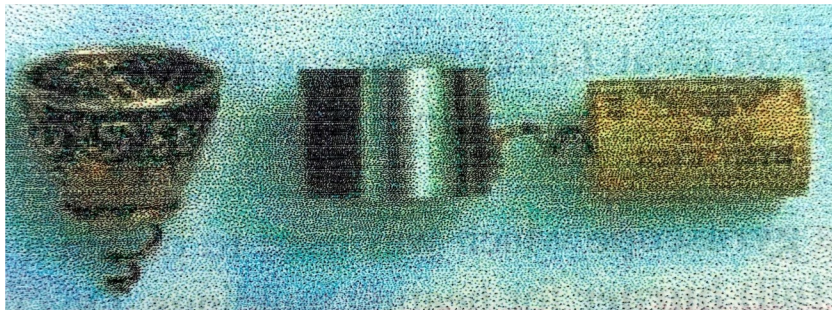
6. A **German** piece in the form of a **shoe** with horn scales, two knife blades and a corkscrew. The tang of the blades are marked **Ges. Geschutzt**. From heel to toe it measures 3 1/4 inches. Milt had previously shown this one in 1985. We thought to include is again this year. We believe it is quite uncommon.

7. A combination folding corkscrew from **Patagonia**. Marked on the sides **Obsequio Ginerals**. There is a folding corkscrew, a folding knife steel which extends beyond the length of the piece as well as a notched segment whose function I do not know. A very interesting piece.

8. Even a **Nifty** can be a **status symbol**, especially when it is made of **14 carat gold**. This is **Harry Vaughan's** (Chicago, Illinois) **US patent No. 1,207,100 of December 15, 1916**. Limited production. It is marked **14K**. Inscribed in the rectangular box on one side is **JOE YOUNG**. Now, just maybe, the **Nifty** will get some respect.

9. A late arrival - pictured along with a version of J. Henry Zellin's Dose Cup Bottle Stopper, US pat. No. 254,760 - patented Mar. 7, 1882, is an example of **Johann B. von Furstenwüirther's** patent for another medicine cup and stopper (**US Pat. No. 377,483 - patented Feb. 7, 1888**) - 6 years later. Johann was a resident of Brooklyn, New York. In essence he thought it best to place the

**The Connection Between David McBain Syme
and
Malcolm III Can(e)more, King of Scotland**

David McBain Syme was born in Dunfermline, Scotland and his family came to America and first settled in Westerly, RI and later moved to Newport, Rhode Island. His mother was Elizabeth McBain. According to an aunt she was the direct descendant of Malcolm III Canemore, King of Scotland in the early 11th century (1058). Malcolm III's castle was in Dunfermline which is located at an inlet of the Firth of Forth in the vicinity of Edinburgh.

Both Malcolm III and his son, Don Bane (that's how it was spelled at that time) who also ascended the throne as king of Scotland, were characters in Shakespeare's tragedy **Macbeth**.

Shakespeare freely adapted the story of Macbeth with some degree of poetic license from Raphael Holinshed's *Chronicles of England, Scotland and Ireland* (1577).

As you may recall medieval Scottish history, Macbeth slew Duncan I near Elgin, Scotland on August 14, 1040 and seized the throne. In 1054 Siward, the Earl of Northumbria, invaded the country on behalf of Duncan's son, Malcolm, who defeated and killed Macbeth in 1057. Malcolm succeeded to the throne as Malcolm III Canemore.

As mentioned above, David McBain Syme's family can trace direct lineage to Malcolm III of the 11th century Scotland.

In recent years David McBain Syme's two daughters while on a tour of Scotland visited the Dunfermline Tower whose remnants are still visible today.

The photograph of David McBain Syme and the accompanying family history were graciously shared with us by his daughter.

15th Annual Midwest Breweriana Convention at Council Bluffs, Iowa Oct 8-11 1997

Shirley worked Thursday morning till 8:30, so we didn't get away until 9:00 AM. We stopped at only 2 malls on our way to Don & Cora Whelan's in Savannah, MO, a little more than half-way to Council Bluffs, Iowa. Picked up a N-58 Conant Hotel-Omaha, a HT-H Aftel-Detroit and a RBO-D Elrajah Havana Cigars just because they were a good price. We arrived at the Whelan's about 3:00 PM. After a few beers and some "give and take" on our traders, Don came out with a D-15-1 Excelsior St Louis Red Feather Beer "power house". That really got me going. We went to supper in St. Joe and returned for some more "trading talk". Don and I went to bed long after the ladies. We both decided to sleep on it. We both knew this was going to be the "mother of all trades"!

We arrived in Council Bluffs about 11:00 AM (Friday). We both immediately started going room-to-room. Cora and Shirley headed for the casino. Don and I didn't find too much - however we found Larry Biehl in a room resting and talking to a pretty lady. Don and I took him back to Fran. Friday evening we all went to the auction. Lots of breweriana changed hands - but no openers or cork-screws. After a visit to the hospitality room we turned in early. Saturday morning set-up found Don and I starting early. Larry B. didn't show up till 10:00 AM. The show had 127 registered guests - 160 show tables and 275 "walk-ins". Don sure was on a roll, as he won six times on the Saturday show raffles! I forgot to get a list of openers Don and Larry found. I was just too busy in "my own little world".

I got the D-15-1 Excelsior for my N-21-1 A-B Budweiser Malt, N-42-2 Bush Bavarian, P-37-1 Mound City Malt and I had to "gulp" and "clinch" the trade with a L-3-3 Michelob. We didn't stop there. I traded a N-88-1 Dixie for Don's F-17-1 Adel Brau. Catching our breath we started another trade. My N-40-2 Bud for Don's C-45-8 Bud Light, C-45-UL Bud Ice, a set of 4 A-B Q-9s, an unlisted Bud barmaid's glove for twist-off crowns, 3 Q-18s, a set of 5 A-B Q-53 twist-offs and a R-15 Bud. Off to the hospitality room and the casino. Cora and Shirley were the unlucky ones. Fran Biehl was a winner, but she wouldn't say how much. We were all joined at the banquet supper Saturday night by the Biehl's daughter who lives across the Missouri river in Omaha. Shirley and I each won an attendance prize to "top off" the evening.

After good-byes Sunday morning, we drove 450 miles home without turning off the windshield wipers. We stopped at several antique malls along the way. I only purchased a 5 inch red fireplug opener that I have never seen before for \$30.00. A real "HEAVY DUTY" weekend. This is what "collecting" and retirement is all about. Wishing all a very happy holiday and hoping to see you all in San Francisco in April of 1998.

Buying Openers and Corkscrews on the Internet through the Ebay Auction

Even if you don't own a computer I am sure you have heard about exploring the internet. With internet access you can see information and correspond with any other person around the world who also has internet access. One of the advantages is also being able to participate either as a bidder or seller in an internet auction service called Ebay. The company is based in California and for a small commission (from \$.50 on low selling items up to about \$10 for a \$1000 item) you can sell anything you want. Of course anything also includes openers, corkscrews and breweriana items in general. At any one time there are usually about 100 opener lots and about 40 to 50 corkscrew lots being offered.

The seller places an item out for auction his or herself with a description and usually a picture (the seller needs either a digital camera or scanner). The item is listed as a 3,5 or 7 day auction with 7 days being the norm. The seller can place a high starting bid (the higher the starting bid the more commission the seller pays) or they can start the bidding low and place a reserve on the item (the reserve also costs the seller a low fee). As soon as the item is listed with Ebay the clock starts ticking for the auction to end. Time remaining in days, hours and minutes is shown along with the current high bid. Each item is given a 7 or 8 digit log number but items are usually found by doing a search. If the seller has a bottle opener he would at least have the word opener in his heading. If he had a combination opener and corkscrew he would have both words in the heading. When a prospective bidder does a search on opener, all items with that word in their heading will appear on the screen with the earliest closing date item appearing first. Lots of junk openers are sold and I have seen at least 100 O-5 Coca-Cola openers sold since May.

If you wish to bid on an item, you are told what the next highest bid increment is (usually \$.50 over the high bid shown but can be 1% of high bid shown for items over \$50). When you enter your bid you can bid the high amount required or you can go ahead and bid whatever you are willing to pay. For example an item shows a high bid of \$10 and I need to bid \$10.50 to become high bidder, I can go ahead and bid \$20. The person who owns the current high bid of \$10 may have entered \$15 as his highest bid when he became high bidder. You don't know how much someone has entered so lets say I place my \$20 bid in. Ebay automatically has a little auction between me and the high bidder. In the example I am showing I would come back as the high bidder at \$15.50 and I would have Ebay go up to \$20 against anyone bidding against me. Anytime you are outbid or you become high bidder Ebay notifies you by E-Mail.

Usually for a very desirable item interested bidders will wait until the very last 10 minutes to start bidding. Remember that Ebay shows the time as it counts down. I have taken this approach a couple of times and you are definitely at the mercy of the computer. If your computer locks up or phone communications mess up or Ebay computer is slow you can lose out. I started bidding on the Winking Eye Boy wall mount with 15 minutes to go. It was at \$220 and I entered \$300. Within a minute the response I received from Ebay was that I had been outbid by another bidder. The high bid was now \$303. I bid again at \$400 and once again I was outbid at \$404. I finally placed a bid of \$550 and was outbid at \$565 with 3 minutes to go. Pat was watching and having a fit (bigger than Shirley Hibbeler did at the St. Joe convention when Ollie bid \$100 on an opener) at me paying this much for an opener but it sure looked nice in the picture. Obviously the person who high bidder at \$220 had actually bid at least \$565 and was probably upset I had run the bid up at the last minute.

On the flip side when I won out on the O-18 Coca-Cola Protector Co wall mount I was the only bidder. The seller had cut a picture out of a Coca-Cola book and said she had that opener.

Buying Openers and Corkscrews on the Internet through the Ebay Auction (Continued)

When an auction closes the seller contacts you by E-Mail and lets you know what shipping cost are. Most expect a money order or cashier's check. Out of all of my purchases on Ebay this one took the longest, close to a month to finish. I always send a money order as soon I receive the E-Mail on postage. In this case the reason it took so long was that woman had spotted the opener on a friend's barn and was only going to take it down if it actually sold. Of course you can imagine the condition once I received it. She had mentioned "some rust" in the description but it was real rusty. I complained back to her via E-Mail and she offered a full refund but since the O-18 is such a tough wall mount to come by I kept it. All of my other transactions have worked out well. At this time my main competition for openers from JFO members comes only from Ray Hanson. Most of the openers sold are either soda or common can piercers but every week sees at least one nice opener being offered. Also a lot of cast iron figural bottle openers are sold with most being the common ones.

I started bidding on openers and corkscrews last May,

The opener shown to the right has sold several times on Ebay. It is a recent opener but always advertised as old. The first time it sold it brought \$113 and I was caught up in the bidding. Please beware. Another newly made piece that brought \$91 on Ebay is a Coca-Cola A-21 spinner made just like the A-21 Jack Daniels spinner (the words "Spin to see who wins" are in the bottom right corner of the opener and the back has no wording). Almost every old A-21 I have seen has something stamped on the back. The Coca-Cola A-21 is also brass-tone like the Jack Daniels. Be careful and don't pay a premium (good advice says Pat). I would rate the cast iron girl opener shown \$5-\$10 and the A-21 Coca-Cola \$5. There are also several versions of cast iron openers recently made being sold as old. They include a Santa Claus and Uncle Sam openers. Buyer beware.

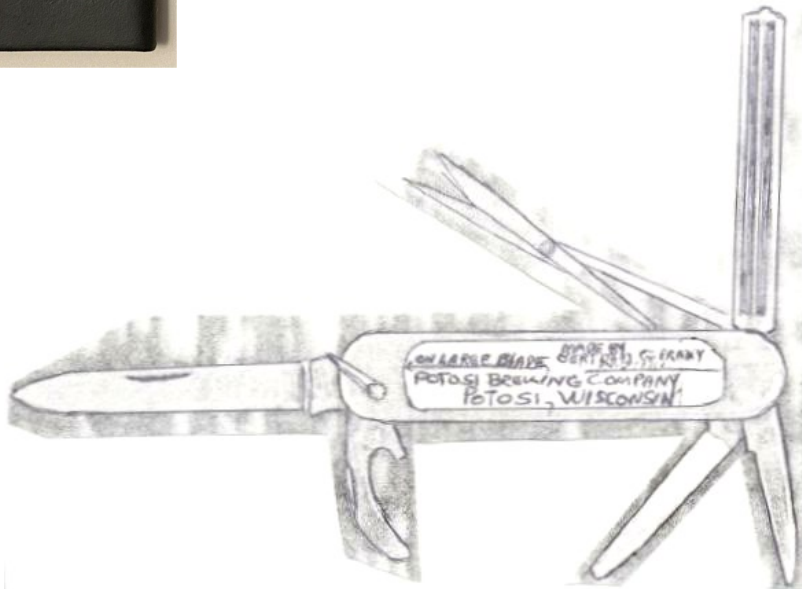

Spouse's Corner

Openers 101

How exciting!!! I decided to take a closer look at figurals, Type A Openers. The handbook has more information than I have here, but this little table is something I can carry around in my early days of collecting. Don't tell John, but I could even get interested in his hobby (I want to find a turtle). You have to know a little before you want to know a lot. If I did not have this column, I would not know anything, as the expert has little patience with this very green novice.

I sorted the types by the General Description column, so all the ladies, bottles, etc. would be together and I could compare them. In some cases there is not enough information to make a comparison, then curiosity directs me to the Handbook to learn more.

Now, when I look at a Colonial Man or another opener, the value is one of my first questions, so the prices listed in the 1997 Handbook Price Guide is an important column in my table.

The # Listed in the 1997 Handbook, is the number of different engravings listed for that specific opener type. If there are only 2 listed and I find the type, I will be flipping the Handbook open to see if I have one that is not yet listed and I will just let Mr. Stanley know that the Handbook is not complete!!!

Gas Key or NO Gas Key seems to have some influence on the price. The Year of Patent just makes me feel young in comparison.

In reality, I'm not real young and may not learn if something is an A-20 or A-50 real soon, but I will remember things such as the fact that a boxing glove and an eagle on a shield are worth some money. John probably not only knows the type, he probably reads the engraved opener and says, "That's an A-21, listing #107. Now if he could learn what cupboard is used for cups!

As you look over this table, I think I will take a little tour of some openers in our home. I think there is a boxing glove, or was at one time. Better check out the eagles too.

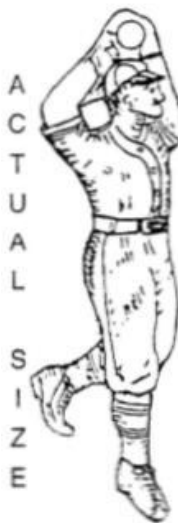

The wonderful arrangement of keeping sellers together on the first three floors instead of being forced to endure constant elevator tie-ups from roaming the enormous hotel top to bottom kept me wanting to room-hop myself. Every single room I entered was enjoyable, even if it didn't feature material in which I am personally interested. The offerings were all old, original, well presented and exciting to see. Combining a silent auction with a buffet lunch, keeping everyone there and interested, was

an excellent idea. If I had any complaints it would have to be directed at the floor auction, which needs some help. But even that was well organized with an above-average group of quality pieces in all ranges. My biggest thrill was finding that this group does not tolerate phony, bogus or reproduction material in their auction. If I had one wish during this AAAA convention, it would be to take the group of people who put together certain other conventions and show them what a collectors' convention should be like. I truly hope they find out before it is too late and they lose the heart and soul of the convention attendees, the traditional collectors who add the education, history, first-hand information and knowledge that well rounded collectors possess. In any case, for those of you interested in joining AAAA and attending next year's convention in Chicago and receiving their color newsletter *Past Times* eight times a year, write to AAAA, P O Box 1121, Morton Grove, IL 60053.
