## Wildflowers



Wildflowers start appearing at Capulin Volcano in late March and bloom through mid-October. Depending on the amount of precipitation, the grasslands at the base of the volcano will either be covered in blooms in June or just have a few brightly colored patches of flowers. The following flowers are commonly seen when hiking trails around Capulin Volcano. For a complete list of wildflowers found here, see the back of this brochure.



**Dotted Gayfeather**  
*(Liatris punctata)*  
Blooming from August to September, this purple flower can be found in the prairie at the base of the volcano and is a favorite of bees. Another name for it is the blazing star.



**Wavyleaf Thistle**  
*(Cirsium undulatum)*  
Blooming throughout the summer, this purple flower can be seen near the base of the volcano in the prairie. Though several other thistles are non-native, this one is a native species.



**Plains Wallflower**  
*(Erysimum asperum)*  
Blooming from late April to July, this yellow flower can be found along the Boca and Lava Flow trails at the base of the volcano in the prairie.




**Plains Prickly Pear Cactus**  
*(Opuntia polyacantha)*  
Blooming in June and July, this yellow flower can be seen both at the base and top of the volcano. While the buds look pink, the flowers are yellow with a sometimes reddish tinge.



**Cowpen Daisy**  
*(Verbesina encelioides)*  
Blooming from late July to early October, these yellow flowers grow in clusters along the Lava Flow Trail and Volcano Road. A lover of disturbed areas, this member of the Aster family, can be found near cinder slides.



**Prickly Poppy**  
*(Argemone hispida)*  
Blooming throughout the summer, this large white flower can be found at both the base and top of the volcano. Broken leaves exude a poisonous sap which deters animals from eating it.



**Indian Paintbrush**  
*(Castilleja integra)*  
Blooming from April to August, this orangy-red flower can be found at both the base and top of the volcano. A parasite of other plants, the orange parts of the flower are actually modified leaves called bracts.



**Beardlip Penstemon**  
*(Penstemon barbatus)*  
Blooming from June to August, this red flower can be found near the top of the volcano and is a favorite of hummingbirds.



**Wood's Rose**  
*(Rosa woodsii)*  
Blooming in May and June, this pink flower is found in shaded areas near both the top of the volcano and along the Boca trail. A wild rose, its sweet scent is characteristic of other members of the rose family.



**Silvery Lupine**  
*(Lupinus argenteus)*  
Blooming from June to August, this purple flower can be seen in the prairie at the base of the volcano. A member of the pea family, it is a relation of the Texas bluebonnet, but a separate species.



### Plains Coneflower

(*Ratibida columnifera*)

Blooming mid summer, these yellow flowers dot the prairie at the base of the volcano on a wet year. Occasionally the yellow petals will have a tinge of red.



### Common Mullein

(*Verbascum thapsus*)

Blooming in July and August, this tall yellow flower spike with fuzzy leaves can be found throughout the park. A non-native species from Eurasia, steps are taken here to control its spread.
