Laelia [Brazilian Orchidist and original collector of species

<P>Found in southeastern Bahia Brazil in the humid Atlantic
rainforests at elevations of 200 to 300 meters as a small sized,
hot to warm growing epiphyte with a single, coriaceous,
lanceolate, dorsal side red leaf that blooms in the summer on a
terminal, erect, short, 4 to 6, simultaneously flowered
inflorescence

<P>This is a new combination that has now been published
and is legal by new regs with the *International Code of Botanical
Nomenclature*. This species does not fit well in

any of the previous combinations listed above starting with the
basionym *Dungsia marcaliana* Campacci & Chiron, *Richardiana* 2: 77 (2002,

<P>Similar to *Laelia harpophylla* but differs in *Laelia marcaliana*
having slightly longer pseudobulbs, wider leaves, 4 to 6 flowers
sepals that are wider than 6mm, a lip that is narrow all along
and has an acute apex as well as comparatively long, lateral
lobes of the lip that overlap the midlobe. ,
