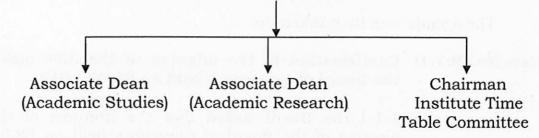

We have audited the attached Balance Sheet of Indian Institute of Technology, Roorkee (IITR) as on 31 March 2012, the Income & Expenditure Account and Receipts & Payments Account for the year ended on that date under Section 19(2) of the Comptroller & Auditor General's (Duties, Powers & Conditions of Service) Act, 1971 read with Section 23 (2) of the Institute of Technology Act, 1961. These financial statements are the responsibility of the IITR's Management. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit.

- 2. This Separate Audit Report contains the comments of the Comptroller & Auditor General of India (CAG) on the accounting treatment only with regard to classification, conformity with the best accounting practices, accounting standards and disclosure norms, etc. Audit observation on financial transactions with regard to compliance with the Law, Rules & Regulations (Propriety and Regularity) and efficiency-cum-performance aspects, etc., if any, are reported through Inspection Report/CAG's Audit Reports separately.
- 3. We have conducted our audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in India. These standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the tinancial statements are free from material misstatements. An audit includes examining, on test basis, evidences supporting the amounts and disclosure in the financial statements. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of financial statements. We believe that our audit provides a reasonable basis for our opinion.



4. Based on our audit, we report that:

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- We have obtained all the information and explanations, which to the best of our knowledge and belief were necessary for the purpose of our audit;
- ii. The Balance Sheet, Income & Expenditure Account and Receipts & Payments Account dealt with by this report have been drawn up in the format approved by the Ministry of Finance, Government of India.
- iii. In our opinion, proper books of accounts and other relevant records have been maintained by IITR as required under section 23 (1) of the Institute of Technology Act, 1961 in so far as it appears from our examination of such books.
- iv. We further report that:

### A. Balance Sheet

### A.1 Fixed Assets- ₹ 1242.99 crore

As per Accounting Policy no.6(b) of Schedule 10 'Significant Accounting Policies', Institute had not charged depreciation on fixed assets which is against the guidelines of common format of accounts prescribed by the Government of India. Consequently Depreciation during the year was understated by ₹91.04 crore (As per the rate of depreciation prescribed in IT Act 1961) and fixed assets were overstated by the same amount.

#### B: Grant in Aid

Out of the grants -in -aid of ₹307.26 crore (₹120.33 crore under plan and ₹186.93 crore under non plan) received during the year, and taking the opening balances of ₹3.06 crore (₹2.73 crore under plan and ₹0.33 crore under non plan), the organization could utilize a sun of ₹286.95 crore (₹109.48 crore under plan and ₹177.47 crore under non plan) leaving a balance of 23.37 crore (₹13.58 crore under plan and ₹9.79 crore undernon plan) as unutilized Grant as on 31 March 2012

- v. Subject to our observation in the preceding paragraphs, we report that the Balance Sheet, Income & Expenditure Account and Receipts & Payments Account dealt with by this report are in agreement with the books of accounts.
- vi. In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the said financial statements read together with the Accounting Policies and Notes on Accounts, and subject to the significant matters stated above and other matters mentioned in Annexure to this Audit Report give a true and fair view in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in India:
- a. In so far as it relates to the Balance Sheet, of the state of affairs of the Indian Institute of Technology, Roorkee as at 31 March 2012; and
- b. In so far as it relates to Income & Expenditure Account of the surplus for the year ended on the date.

Case I— Shortfall of items and missing of few pages of T& P Register(Vol.V) of F&A Lab. Electrical Engineering Department during the tenure of Sri K.K.Sharma, Senior Technical Superintendent.

Prof. & Head has informed vide his note dated 17<sup>th</sup> Sept. 2012 that DPC of the department had considered the report of the Committee constituted by the department to check each and every item of the laboratory physically on shortfall of items and lost of T&P Register(Vol.V) of F&A Lab. The above committee perused the documents and reply dated 27.12.2012 given by the Head of the department on the points raised by the General Section. Perusal of record indicates the following:-

(i) that a complaint was lodged on 18.08.2010 at Kotwali, Roorkee.

(ii) closing report given by the Police on 1st June, 2011.

(iii) physical verification was carried out by the Committee constituted by the department for this purpose and it has been found and reported that after due verification, missing items/pages of the T&P Register (Vol.V) of F&A Lab. Missing items are minor assets.

(iv) book value can not be ascertained in absence of the missing pages from the

T&P Register.

Based on the position as above and taking into consideration the life time of 4-5 years of minor assets as per the Store Rules, this committee recommends to write off the missing items being the minor assets.

Further a stern warning also be issued to Sri K.K.Sharma, Senior Technical Superintendent.

# Case-II Missing of books from the departmental library of EED during tenure of Sri D.C. Ganguly. Technical Superintendent

Prof. & Head, Electrical Engineering Department has forwarded the resolution of the Departmental Professorial Committee (DPC) on lost books intimating that 313 books were found missing from the departmental library. In the said note it has been mentioned that out of these books, missed books during the tenure of Sri Ganguly are 161.

The Committee also taken into account the reply dated 29.11.2012 from Sri D.C.Ganguly with respect to show-cause notice issued to him and his subsequent representation to the Deputy Director and Director on 11.02.2013.

Rule 194 in General Financial Rules(GFR) on physical verification of library books and permissible lost was perused along with the Board Resolution BG/15/2012 on charging of depreciated value on the assets of the Institute including library books @ 10% on the basis of Written Down Value Method (WDVM). It has been noted that after long gap a formal physical verification of the Department Library was being carried out.

The Committee after taking all the facts and circumstances into its consideration and deliberations on the issue, recommends that:-

- (i) the depreciated cost on assets @ 10% as per the Board Resolution be recovered from Sri Ganguly.
- (ii) simultaneously, recommended that an stern warning also be issued to Sri Ganguly.
- (iii) however, since responsibility of the lost of books i.e., 313-161 = 152 books before 2008 can not be ascertained, as the departmental library remained in the charge of different persons from time to time during that period. Under the circumstances, the missing books be written off.
- (iv) the Head of Department is also advised to make a proper arrangement for the entry of books for issue and return in the departmental library and ensure the physical verification every year as per the GFR Rule 194.

We have audited the attached Balance Sheet of Indian Institute of Technology, Roorkee (IITR) as on 31 March 2012, the Income & Expenditure Account and Receipts & Payments Account for the year ended on that date under Section 19(2) of the Comptroller & Auditor General's (Duties, Powers & Conditions of Service) Act, 1971 read with Section 23 (2) of the Institute of Technology Act, 1961. These financial statements are the responsibility of the IITR's Management. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit.

- 2. This Separate Audit Report contains the comments of the Comptroller & Auditor General of India (CAG) on the accounting treatment only with regard to classification; conformity with the best accounting practices, accounting standards and disclosure norms, etc. Audit observation on financial transactions with regard to compliance with the Law, Rules & Regulations (Propriety and Regularity) and efficiency-cum-performance aspects, etc., if any, are reported through Inspection Report/CAG's Audit Reports separately.
- 3. We have conducted our audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in India. These standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatements. An audit includes examining, on test basis, evidences supporting the amounts and disclosure in the financial statements. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of financial statements. We believe that our audit provides a reasonable basis for our opinion.

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- 4. Based on our audit, we report that:
- i. We have obtained all the information and explanations, which to the best of our knowledge and belief were necessary for the purpose of our audit;
- ii. The Balance Sheet, Income & Expenditure Account and Receipts & Payments Account dealt with by this report have been drawn up in the format approved by the Ministry of Finance, Government of India.
- iii. In our opinion, proper books of accounts and other relevant records have been maintained by IITR as required under section 23 (1) of the Institute of Technology Act, 1961 in so far as it appears from our examination of such books.
- iv. We further report that :.

#### A. Balance Sheet

### A.1 Fixed Assets-₹ 1242.99 crore

As per Accounting Policy no.6(b) of Schedule 10 'Significant Accounting Policies', Institute had not charged depreciation on fixed assets which is against the guidelines of common format of accounts prescribed by the Government of India. Consequently Depreciation during the year was understated by ₹91.04 crore (As per the rate of depreciation prescribed in IT Act 1961) and fixed assets were overstated by the same amount.

### B : Grant in Aid

Out of the grants -in -aid of ₹ 307.26 crore (₹120.33 crore under plan and ₹ 186.93 crore under non plan) received during the year, and taking the opening balances of ₹3.06 crore (₹2.73 crore under plan and ₹ 0.33 crore under non plan), the organization could utilize a sum of ₹ 286.95 crore (₹109.48 crore under plan and ₹177.47 crore under non plan) leaving a balance of 23.37 crore (₹13.58 crore under plan and ₹ 9.79 crore under non plan) as unutilized Grant as on 31 March. 2012.

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- v. Subject to our observation in the preceding paragraphs, we report that the Balance Sheet, Income & Expenditure Account and Receipts & Payments Account dealt with by this report are in agreement with the books of accounts.
- vi. In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations-given to us, the said financial statements read together with the Accounting Policies and Notes on Accounts, and subject to the significant matters stated above and other matters mentioned in Annexure to this Audit Report give a true and fair view in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in India:
- a. In so far as it relates to the Balance Sheet, of the state of affairs of the Indian Institute of Technology, Roorkee as at 31 March 2012; and
- b. In so far as it relates to Income & Expenditure Account of the surplus for the year ended on the date.
