The History



Robert Leicht sets up a brewery in a pub while Councillor of Commerce. Later, this Brewery is renamed **Schwaben Bräu**.





1888 Carl Dinkelacker establishes the Dinkelacker Brewery in the centre of Stuttgart where the company is still located today.

David Sanwald establishes the **Sanwald**Brewery in Stuttgart, specialized from the beginning in wheatbeer production.





The History - cont'd

1977 Dinkelacker acquires the Brewery Sanwald.

1996 Dinkelacker and Schwaben Bräu merge: the new entity becomes Dinkelacker-Schwaben Bräu.

Oct 2004 - Dinkelacker-Schwaben Bräu becomes part of Dec 2006 Interbrew/Inbev following the acquisition of the Brewery Spaten by Interbrew. Spaten held a majority stake in Dinkelacker-Schwaben Bräu.

Jan 2007 Wolfgang Dinkelacker, the grandson of the company founder, buys the Brewery back from Inbev, re-establishing it as an independent Brewery and as Baden-Württemberg's largest private brewery.




