

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Conventions used in Repertorium Plantarum Succulentarum

- Repertorium Plantarum Succulentarum attempts to list, under separate headings, newly published names of succulent plants and relevant literature on the systematics of these plants, on an annual basis. New names noted after the issue for the relevant year has gone to press are included in later issues. Specialist periodical literature is scanned in full (as available at the libraries at ZSS and Z or received by the compilers). Also included is information supplied to the compilers direct. It is urgently requested that any reprints of papers not published in readily available botanical literature be sent to the compilers.
- Validly published names are given in **bold face** type (except for epithets of new cultivars), accompanied, in the case of newly described taxa, by an indication of the nomenclatural type (name or specimen dependent on rank), followed by the herbarium acronyms of the herbaria where the holotype and possible isotypes are said to be deposited (first acronym for holotype), according to Index Herbariorum, ed. 8 and supplements as published in Taxon. Invalid, illegitimate, or incorrect names are given in *italic* type face. In either case a full bibliographic reference is given. For new combinations, the basionym is listed. For invalid, illegitimate or incorrect names, the articles of the ICBN or ICNCP which have been contravened are indicated in brackets (note that the numbering of some regularly cited articles has changed in the Tokyo (1994) edition of the ICBN).
- The compilers would like to point out that they do not accept any names that might be inadvertently validated in this volume of RPS.
- Bibliographic details of papers dealing only with the description of one or few new taxa are usually not repeated in the bibliographic section.
- Abbreviations for periodicals are those suggested in 'Bibliography of Succulent Plant Periodicals' (U. Eggli in Friciana 60: 1-139, 1998 ('1995) for specialized periodicals, or those of *Bibliographia Periodicorum Huntianum* Ed. 2 (BPH2) for most other periodicals.

Konventionen im Zusammenhang mit dem Repertorium Plantarum Succulentarum

- Das Repertorium Plantarum Succulentarum ist eine jährlich herausgegebene Zusammenstellung neuer Namen für sukkulente Pflanzen und der relevanten systematischen Literatur. Neue Namen, die nach der Drucklegung der Ausgabe des betreffenden Jahres bekannt werden, erscheinen in der nächsten erreichbaren Ausgabe. Spezialisierte Zeitschriften werden umfassend durchgesehen, soweit sie in den Bibliotheken von Z und ZSS vorhanden sind oder den Herausgebern privat vorliegen. Die Herausgeber bitten alle Autoren dringend, Separata relevanter Publikationen zur Verfügung zu stellen, vor allem wenn es sich um Beiträge in schwer zugänglichen Serien handelt.
- Gültig veröffentlichte Namen werden in **Fettschrift** wiedergegeben (ausgenommen Cultivar-Namen), ergänzt durch den nomenklativen Typ für neue Taxa (Name oder Belegexemplar je nach Rangstufe; gefolgt von den Herbarakürzungen [entsprechend Index Herbariorum, ed. 8, und in Taxon publizierten Supplementen] der publizierten Hinterlegungsorte für Holotyp [1. Abkürzung] und Isotypen). Für Umkombinationen wird das Basionym angegeben. Ungültige, illegitime oder falsch angewandte Namen erscheinen in *Kursivschrift* unter Angabe (in Klammer) derjenigen Artikel des ICBN oder ICNCP, die verletzt worden sind. In allen Fällen folgen die kompletten bibliographischen Angaben. Im Weiteren ist zu beachten, dass die Nummerierung einiger häufig zitierten Artikel mit dem Erscheinen der Tokyo-Version (1994) des ICBN geändert hat.
- Die Herausgeber weisen mit aller Deutlichkeit darauf hin, dass sie keinen Namen anerkennen, der zufälligerweise in dieser Ausgabe des RPS validiert worden sein könnte.
- Beiträge, welche nur Beschreibungen eines oder weniger neuer Taxa enthalten, werden in der Regel in der bibliographischen Liste nicht separat aufgeführt.
- Die Abkürzungen für spezialisierte Sukkulanten-Zeitschriften richten sich nach 'Bibliography of Succulent Plant Periodicals' (U. Eggli in Friciana 60: 1-139, 1998 ('1995)), für allgemein botanische Zeitschriften in der Regel nach *Bibliographia Periodicorum Huntianum* Ed. 2 (BPH2).

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Compilers' Preface

With this issue, the Repertorium Plantarum Succulentarum continues to serve the "succulent plant" community by listing taxonomic and bibliographic novelties published during the past year.

While the number of new names published annually seems to be stabilizing, or even declining somewhat, the number of publications (both papers and books) addressing various aspects of succulent plant biology, seems to have been growing considerably in recent years. A certain move is visible away from purely taxonomic research towards more pronouncedly phylogenetic and/or biogeographic studies. The wealth of papers addressing other aspects of succulent plant biology makes it increasingly difficult to assess whether a paper includes sufficient "taxonomic" information to need a citation in these pages. These decisions are not always easy to take, and we hope that our selection of papers from "neighbouring" fields of interest such as phytochemistry, geobotany, or ecology, add to the usefulness of RPS. Listing *all* papers dealing with succulent plants – even though this would without doubt be a worthwhile undertaking – is clearly beyond the possibilities of the compilers of RPS.

The compilation of the RPS for 2008 has considerably benefitted from the valuable volunteer work of Dr. Reiner Mailänder, Zürich. Rainer Mailänder regularly scans a good selection of more "general" biological journals for the purpose of the ZSS library database, and thus also for RPS. We are very grateful for this important help.

Future issues of RPS: Please note that the IOS Board is planning that future issues of RPS will be published and distributed to the majority of IOS members electronically. Printed copies (possibly in A5 booklet format) will continue to be available for members who do not have Internet access on request from the IOS Secretariat. A charge may be made for these copies, to cover the cost of printing and postage. Arrangements for non-IOS subscribers will be announced in due course.

Vorwort der Herausgeber

Auch mit dieser Ausgabe setzt das Repertorium Plantarum Succulentarum die Tradition fort, die Gemeinschaft der an Sukkulanten interessierten Wissenschaftler und Liebhaber mit einer Liste der im vergangenen Jahr veröffentlichten taxonomischen und bibliographischen Neuheiten zu bedienen.

Während sich die Anzahl der jährlich veröffentlichten neuen Namen zu stabilisieren scheint oder vielleicht sogar leicht abnimmt, wächst die Zahl der Publikationen (sowohl Bücher wie Zeitschriftenbeiträge) mit sukkulenten Themen seit einigen Jahren deutlich. Dabei ist eine gewisse Tendenz weg von rein taxonomischen Untersuchungen und hin zu deutlicher phylogenetischen und/oder biogeographischen Themen sichtbar. Die grosse Zahl von Beiträgen zu anderen Aspekten der Biologie sukkulenter Pflanzen macht die Entscheidung zunehmend schwieriger, ob eine Veröffentlichung ausreichend "taxonomische" Informationen enthält, um eine Aufnahme in das RPS zu rechtfertigen. Diese Entscheidungen sind nicht immer einfach zu fällen, und wir hoffen, dass die getroffene Auswahl aus "benachbarten" Interessengebieten (Phytochemie, Geobotanik, oder Ökologie) zur Nützlichkeit des RPS beiträgt. Die Aufnahme *aller* Beiträge, welche sich mit Sukkulanten befassen, liegt

völlig ausserhalb unserer Möglichkeiten, auch wenn ein solches Projekt zweifellos wertvoll wäre.

Die Zusammenstellung des RPS für das Jahr 2008 profitierte in grossem Masse von der freiwilligen Mitarbeit von Dr. Reiner Mailänder, Zürich. Rainer Mailänder beobachtet regelmässig eine umfassende Auswahl von "generellen" biologischen Zeitschiften in Bezug auf interessante Artikel für die Datenbank der ZSS-Bibliothek, und somit auch für das RPS. Wir sind für diese wichtige Hilfe sehr dankbar.

Zukünftige Ausgaben: Es ist zu beachten, dass der Vorstand der IOS gegenwärtig diskutiert, ob zukünftige RPS-Ausgaben nur noch elektronisch veröffentlicht werden sollen, und in ebensolcher Form an die Mehrheit der IOS-Mitglieder abgegeben wird. Eine gedruckte Ausgabe (möglicherweise im Format A5) wäre für IOS-Mitglieder ohne Internet-Anschluss auch in Zukunft auf Bestellung vom IOS-Sekretariat unter Übernahme der Kosten für Druck und Versand erhältlich. Über Bezugsmöglichkeiten für Besteller von ausserhalb der IOS wird zu gegebener Zeit informiert werden.
