(By the Associated Press) NEW YORK, Sept. 25.—There is no evidence of a break in the steel strikers' ranks, according to reports from different sources. The steel companies have not claimed any large defections among the strikers, but several assert the men continue to return to work. The officials of the Bethlehem Steel Company claim that the employees reported for work in such large numbers that virtually all the plants are now in full operation, but the strikers' headquarters have issued a statement to the effect that the Bethlehem Steel Company has been completely crippled. The labor leaders declared tonight that they had won the test of strength which the steel companies planned for today.

BRITISH GOVERNMENT HAS THE RAILROAD STRIKE WELL IN HAND

(By the Associated Press) LONDON, Sept. 25.—Dispatches from the Exchange Telegraph Company says that the government considers that the strike situation is well in hand and it is expecting to see the strikers return to work, the British government's railway strike is well in hand. The Exchange Telegraph Company also says that it is reported that 75 per cent of the engine drivers of the Great Western Railway have returned to work, and that the railway officials expect that comparable figures will be reached in other parts of the country.

All diplomatic appointments by President Lincoln have been cancelled. A cabinet has been nominated as follows: Foreign Minister, Andres Bello; Minister of Public Instruction, Joaquín Rojas; Minister of the Interior, Carlos Jiménez; Minister of Public Works, Pedro Zaldívar; Minister of War, Aquilino Salgado; Minister of Finance, Carlos Arce.

CINCINNATI WILL BE PACKED WITH FANS WEDNESDAY

Cincinnati, O., Sept. 20.—Baseball enthusiasts from all parts of the country will come to Cincinnati Wednesday to see the Cincinnati Nationals and the Chicago White Sox clash in the World series games.

President Harry Herrmann of the Cincinnati Nationals was assigned weeks in advance of the opening of the National League season for tickets for the games by Cincinnati followers of the "Reds" and by fans from every section of the country who desired to witness the games to be played in this city.

Acting on the request of President August Herrmann the Convention and Publicity Department of the Chamber of Commerce named a special committee of five to devise means for best meeting the desires of Mr. Herrmann.

The committee arranged to establish a hotel bureau in charge of a competent staff to look after all requests for accommodations. It was decided to use every available hotel room, and to add to those accommodations a survey of every room in boarding houses and private residences where visitors could be lodged. All these rooms were to be inspected in advance, and could be given attention concerning their desirability.

Word was sent to Washington, D. C. requesting the co-operation of the Railroad Administration in the matter of obtaining desirable parking places for special Pullman cars carrying large private parties to the game. It was expected that many visitors would utilize these cars for sleeping purposes while in the city, providing they had parking places.

Arrangements also were in preparation for suitable parking places for the automobiles of out-of-town visitors and for parking places in the vicinity of the baseball park during the games.

For the protection of patrons visiting Cincinnati and Chicago during the playing of the series, detectives who are specialists in dealing with pickpockets and auto-theives will be very active in both cities. A large number of Chicago plain clothes men will be on duty here while the teams are in Cincinnati and in turn the local reports will mingle with the crowds when the teams shift to Chicago.

AMERICANS HAVE WON 9 OUT OF 14 OF WORLD SERIES

Chicago, Ill., Sept. 20. 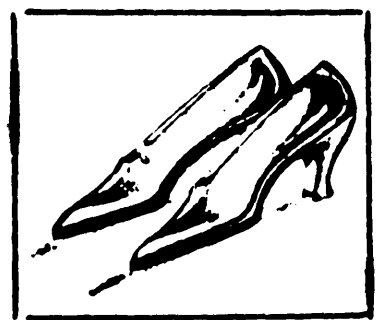

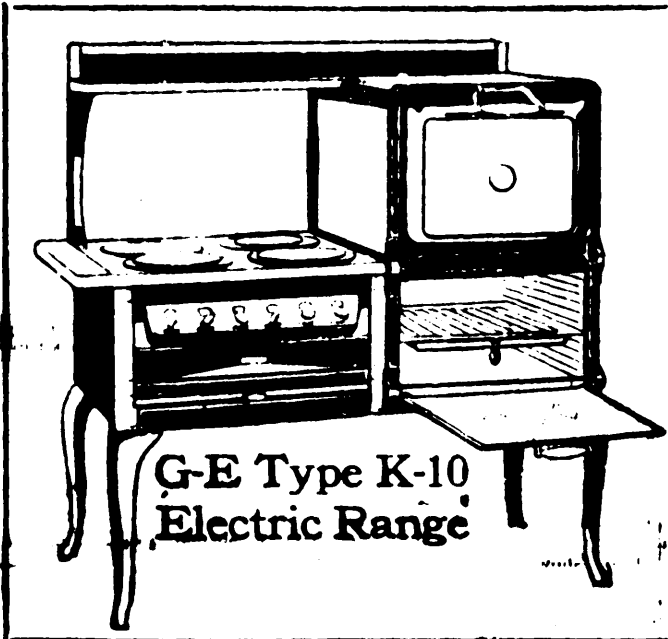
