

## Professor Chittaranjan Yajnik

**Prof CS Yajnik**, Director Diabetes Unit, KEM Hospital Pune, India, is a Consultant Physician, Diabetologist and the Director of Diabetes Unit at the King Edward Memorial Hospital, Pune. In addition, he is an Associate Professor at the BJ Medical College, Pune University, visiting Fellow at the MRC life-course epidemiology Unit at Southampton, UK, and a Visiting University Professor at the Peninsula Medical School at Exeter, UK. He received his M.D. from B.J. Medical College, Pune (1980) and was awarded an honorary FRCP from Royal College of Physicians, London (2004) and an honorary visiting professorship at the Peninsula Medical School, Exeter (2008). Prof Yajnik has worked tirelessly for last 3 decades to investigate the high susceptibility of Indians to diabetes and

possible novel explanations. Prof Yajnik has put India on the international map in the field of diabetology and early life origins of diabetes.
