<i>Cyperus diandrus</i>	DROPPED (no documented occurrences for DPG)
<i>Dryopteris carthusiana</i>	DROPPED (appears secure on USFS and other lands; G5/S3)
<i>Dryopteris cristata</i>	DROPPED (appears secure on USFS and other lands; G5/S3)
<i>Mentzelia pumila</i>	Not K (known) or S (suspected) on SRD
<i>Myosurus apetalus</i> var. <i>montanus</i>	ADDED (K [known] on LMNG)

Hierochloe odorata	State Priority 1 list; 6-7 collections from n. Idaho, known also on Nez Perce NF; need more status info. DO NOT ADD AT THIS TIME.
Lobaria scrobiculata	G3G4/S1, but threats “not currently expected” on IPNFs. DO NOT ADD AT THIS TIME
Orobanche pinorum	G4/S2. If added, IPNFs “would like to review the species’ distribution, ecology and threats before that happens.” DO NOT ADD AT THIS TIME
MONTANA	
Carex chalciolepis	Nominated for addition in Montana (K on Bitterroot); one occurrence in the Anaconda-Pintler Wilderness Area, threats may be low or none. DO NOT ADD AT THIS TIME
Castilleja cervina	Possibly occurs on Flathead NF, specimen not yet confirmed; not currently known on NFS lands in Montana. DO NOT ADD AT THIS TIME
Juncus hallii	Nominated for deletion; 11 EOs currently entered – MTNHP not likely to downlist. RETAIN ON LIST
Lomatium nuttallii	G3/S1, MTNHP SOC; 3 EOs, with 1 new one on Custer NF; role of tribal introduction of populations uncertain. DO NOT ADD AT THIS TIME
Orogenia fusiformis	Nominated for deletion; 11 EOs currently entered – MTNHP not likely to downlist. RETAIN ON LIST
Ranunculus jovis	Nominated for deletion; 11 EOs currently entered – MTNHP not likely to downlist. RETAIN ON LIST
Rhizomnium nudum	Nominated for addition in Montana (K on Lolo, K on Kootenai, S on Flathead); not currently shown on MTNHP list of nonvascular plants, but likely to be tracked in the future. DO NOT ADD AT THIS TIME
Sidalcea oregana	G5/S1, MTNHP SOC; one occurrence in Gallatin Co. may be on Gallatin NF. ADD???
Thelypodium sagittatum	G4/S2, MTNHP SOC; recently documented on Gallatin NF. ADD???
