

## Lesson 38 Answer Key

### A. Translation of **Léigh** section:

1. If my hands were dirty, I would wash them.
2. If hunger were 'on me', I would eat bread.
3. If sleep(iness) were 'on me', I would go to sleep.
4. If the floor were dirty, I would sweep it.

### B. Freagair na Ceisteanna Seo:

(The answers for numbers one through four correspond to the Irish given in the '**A. Léigh**' section. Number five requires the student to determine the best response. Be creative.)

### C. Translation of **Léigh** section:

1. If I were sick, my mother would send for (*literally* 'put knowledge on') the doctor.
2. If the house were 'to go' on fire, my father would call the Fire Brigade
3. If five hundred pounds were 'at me', I would buy a car.
4. If tiredness were 'on me', I would 'rest myself'.
5. If the room were stuffy, I would open the windows.
