



Ed Wilson to receive Stroud Jordan award

*To be presented during the AACT Technical Seminar
on October 23, 2007*

Ed Wilson has been selected as the AACT Stroud Jordan award recipient for 2007. Wilson is currently vice president sales and marketing for North America at AarhusKarlshamn US.

In 1979 he started with US Cocoa in Pennsauken, New Jersey, as assistant warehouse manager, cocoa products. Within three years the company started up a compound coating operation from scratch. Wilson became production manager and within 12 months was supplying various compound coatings to the confectionery and baking industries. This company then became Cocoa Barry at which time Wilson became production manager. He spent 13 years with this organization, learning many aspects of the chocolate and compound manufacturing, leaving Barry Callebaut in 1992 to join Aarhus as a technical service representative to help build their confectionery specialty fat business in the United States. In the following years he became technical sales manager and then

sales and marketing director before being appointed vice president for AarhusKarlshamn US.

Wilson has instructed at the AACT Chicago Section's chocolate school and has lectured at Texas A&M on compound coatings and vegetable fats. He has spoken about palm and lauric oils

for the American Oil Chemists Society in Indonesia. He also presented papers at the PMCA Production Conference and at the AACT Technical seminar.

He is on the board of directors of the PMCA, past chairman of the Philadelphia Chapter AACT, active member of the American Oil Chemists Society and Institute of Food Technologists. He also served on the All Candy Expo supplier subcommittee, on the NCA's supplier advisory board, and has assisted at NCA's courses at University of Wisconsin.
