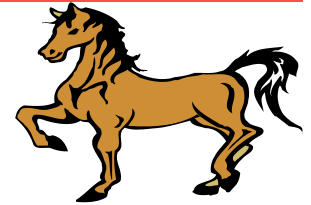

### State Testing

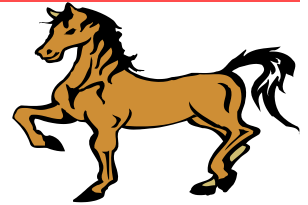
#### May 9 - 13
