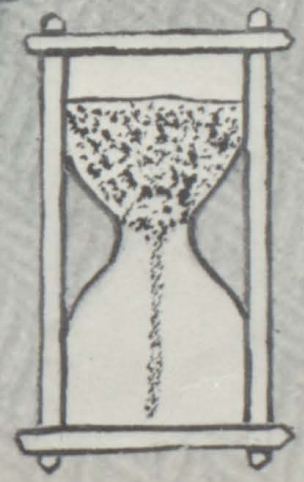
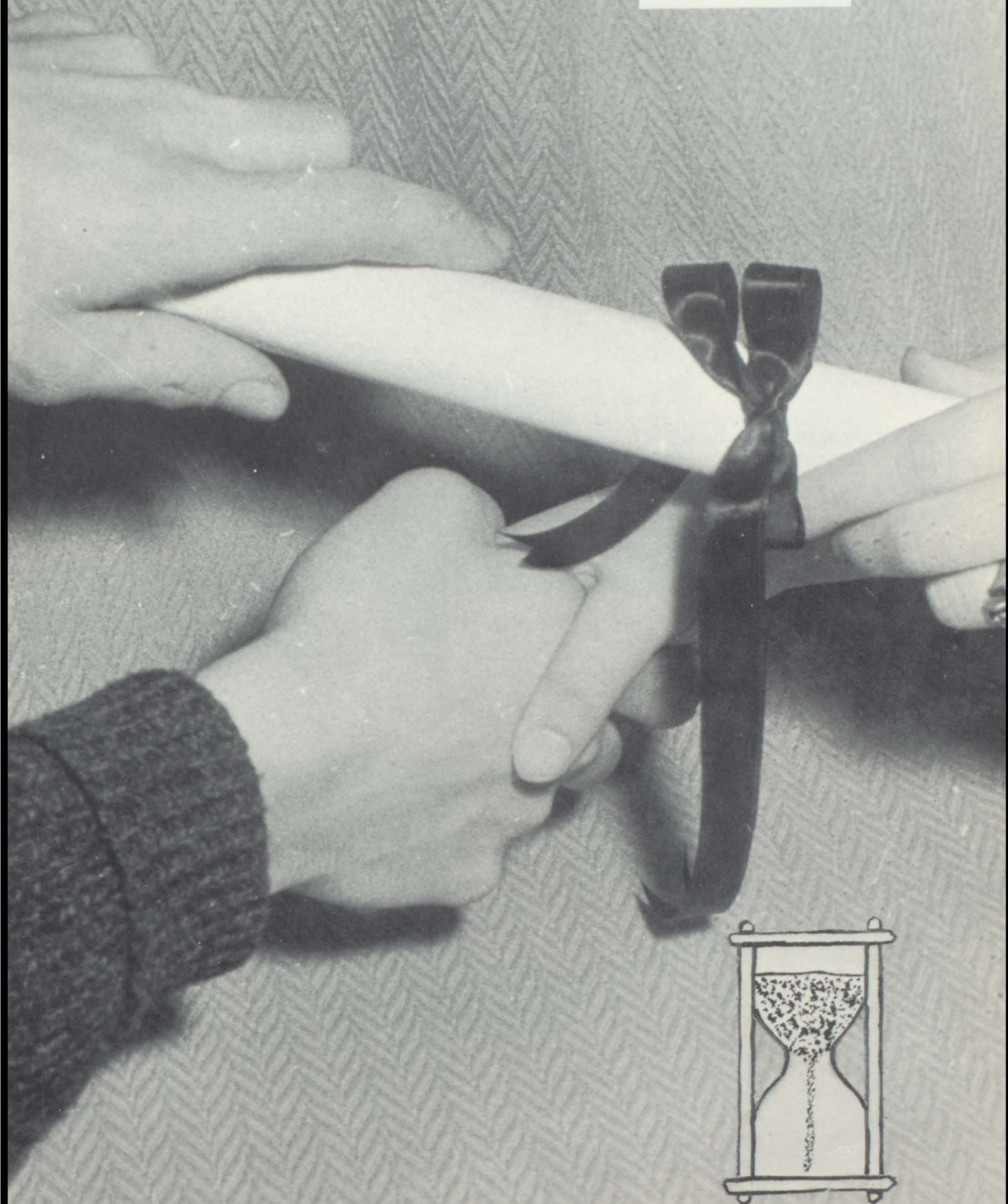
To you, Mr. Berkas, we dedicate our 1961 Annual.

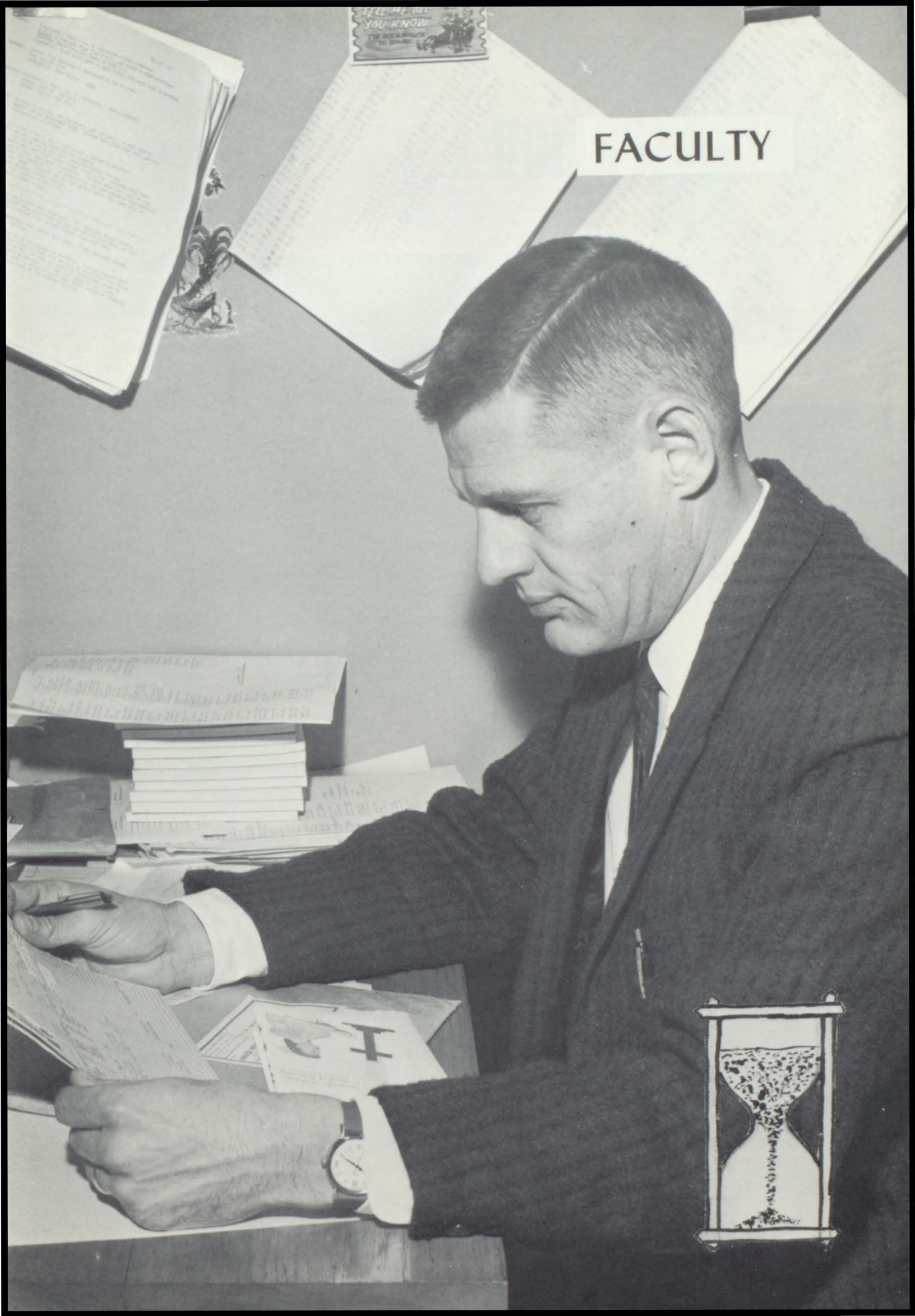
APPRECIATION

Our Senior class also works as an organization. One of our projects is the selling of basketball concessions. Jeanette looks as if she is kept busy, doesn't she?

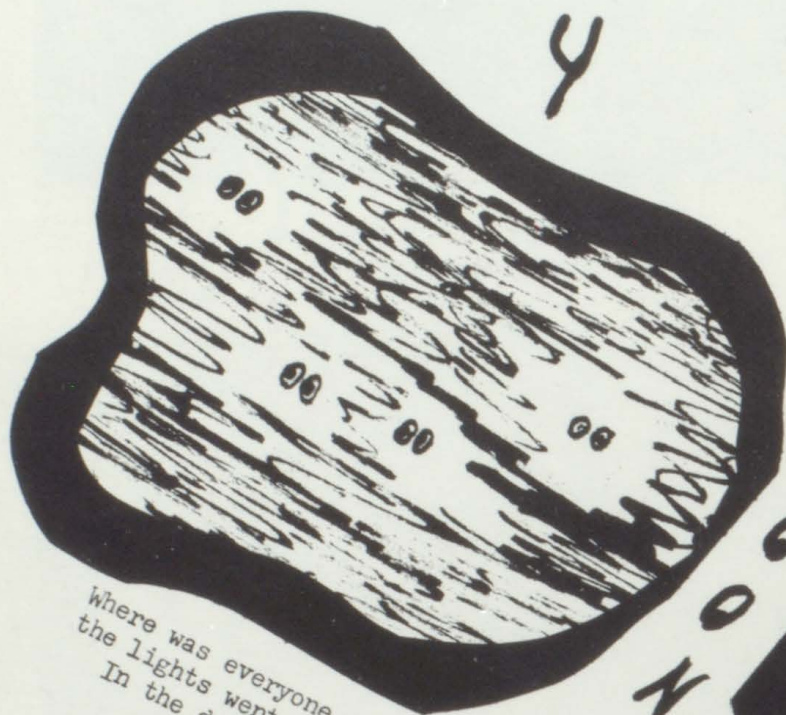

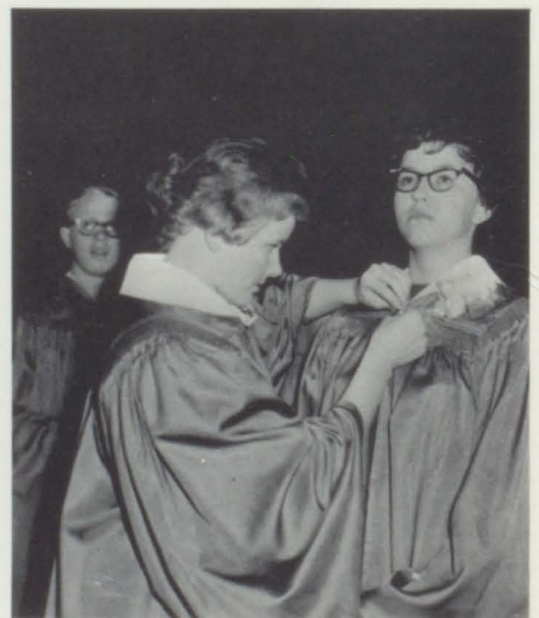
