Shrubs are the backbone of the garden, the starting point for your landscape. Plant them as borders or hedges to define areas, as "foundation plants" to soften the transition from your home to the yard, or as specimens to be a focal point, the center of attention.

Shrubs can be evergreen or deciduous. Some are chosen for their foliage color and texture, others for their flowers or fruit. Some grow as tall as trees while others are groundcovers. Wise placement and use of shrubs can provide privacy, security, order, shade, wildlife habitat and stunning year-round beauty.


These mounding shrubs are easy to grow in sun or part shade; they need little more than an annual prune to keep them shaped nicely.

Barberry

You need to be careful around Barberries. From a safe distance, they are attractive landscape shrubs with bright foliage, but watch out for the thorns! Their prickly nature is one of their chief attributes, a great choice when you want to add an extra layer of security as well as beauty to a flower bed (not a bad choice to go under your daughter's window).

Barberry is tough and adapts itself to just about any growing environment, a quality not everyone appreciates.

In recent years, Barberry has gotten a bad rap from some who claim it is invasive. There are over 400 varieties of Barberry. The one that really causes all the trouble is the green barberry, which we don't grow. Zone 4. \bigcirc

Boxwood

No other shrub is as classy or sophisticated as a well-tended boxwood. Grown as a hedge or border in Mid-Atlantic gardens from early Colonial times to today, Buxus is very tolerant of aggressive pruning, making it a great plant for shaping-as a box, globe or even topiary.

'Green Gem' is low growing and globular, while 'Green Mountain' has an upright pyramid shape. 'Green Velvet' has bright green new growth providing a nice contrast. 'Winter Gem' is a hardy variety that displays a rich golden hue in the winter. O 👛



Conifer Juniper

Junipers are admired for their texture and color: from yellow to green to blue. They are tough and adaptable to harsh conditions (like shopping center parking lots) and are fairly drought tolerant, liking full sun.

The smaller varieties are excellent as groundcovers and planting in masses or along borders. The 'Spartan' and 'Torulosa' varieties are taller Junipers with the 'Torulosa' topping off at 20' Tall. These evergreen conifer shrubs don't need much maintenance, only prune every few years. All Junipers hardy to at least Zone 5. ©

Gorgeous Blooms.

Sure, Hydrangeas are beautiful shrubs, and their foliage looks interesting in all seasons. But let's be honest. The only reason we all have a love affair with Hydrangeas is for their wonderful, mop-head blooms. Enjoy them in your landscape or bring them inside as a cut flower.

Mainstays of the American garden since colonial times, modern varieties offer unique attributes. Some, like 'Endless Summer,'® rebloom, even on new growth. Others, like the 'Cityline'® series, maintain a tight, compact habit.

It's a good time to be a gardener.

Arborescens

Native to the Eastern United States, Hydrangea arborescens is a deciduous shrub once used medicinally by Native Americans. The bark has a peculiar tendency to peel off in several successive thin layers with different colors.

The best known cultivar is 'Annabelle.' Its small snowball flowers gradually turn from green to pure white. An improved variety based on 'Annabelle', 'Incrediball®', has huge blooms.

The iconic hydrangea, Macrophylla, has large green leaves and mop-head blooms in blue or pink, depending on the soil pH. If you have pink and want blue, add aluminum sulfate. Are your blooms blue, but prefer pink? Then add lime. These grow to 7' Tall and Wide. Zone 6. 🔅 🖄

Crape Myrtle

No other tree or shrub can rival the show Crape Myrtles put on in the summer. Flower spikes of pink, purple, red, and white dazzle the eyes in the dead heat of July and August.

Their leaves turn brilliant red and orange in fall. Their peeling bark bring winter interest.

A very easy tree to grow, Crapes thrive in heat and humidity, tolerate drought, and grow very quickly. Pay close attention to the mature size listed in the tables. Make sure you don't plant them too close together. Due to the fast growth, some prune them too aggresively. To keep its form in shape, selective winter pruning is recommended (but please don't stump-cut them...its just not necessary and it shortens its life span). Plant Crape Myrtle in full Sun.

Many of the most popular trees are produced by modern methods. Maples, Magnolias, and Crape Myrtles can be fairly easily propagated asexually by rooting cuttings. In recent years, Maples in particular have most commonly been created in laboratories via tissue culture. This has allowed rapid development and crops of trees that are exact genetic replicas.

But the oak has proven difficult to root, and so far impossible to reliably create via petri dishes. We grow all our oaks from acorns, which means no two trees are quite the same.

And we figure that's the way nature wants it.
