LIMERICK COUNTY COUNCIL. Scheme for Scholarships From Primary to Secondary Schools in County Limerick.

NUMBER OF SCHOLARSHIPS. Six of the annual value of £40. The Committee shall be at liberty to reduce the value of the Scholarship where the pupil's parents or guardians are in a position to bear part of the expense of his or her education.

CONDITIONS OF TENURE. (A) The Primary School from which the pupil comes must have adopted the Gaelic League Education Programme as modified by Dail Eireann.

TENURE OF SCHOLARSHIPS. The tenure of these Scholarships shall be four years provided the pupil shows satisfactory progress as tested by (a) the periodical school examination, (b) the annual school examination.

RESIDENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS. Scholarships shall be restricted to pupils who are of Irish birth and whose parents or guardians have been resident in the County for five years.

OTHER QUALIFICATIONS. Children of labourers or farmers whose valuation does not exceed £20 shall be entitled to a full Scholarship.

AGE LIMIT. Pupils shall be eligible for Scholarships up to but not exceeding 16 years on the first of June.

REFERENCES. Every candidate for a Scholarship shall, before being admitted for examination, produce a satisfactory reference from the Teacher or school manager of his school, together with a medical certificate as to fitness, and a recommendation from a Clergyman of his parish as to character.

EXAMINATION. Candidates for Scholarships shall be written to a competitive examination—oral and written—to be held by Examiners appointed by the Committee.

GENERAL POWERS. The Committee reserve to themselves the right to modify any condition from which a Scholarship is granted, without assigning a reason.

SYLLABUS. The following is the list of subjects for examination (written and oral) as may be necessary:—IRISH, IRISH HISTORY, LATIN, FRENCH, ARITHMETIC, ALGEBRA, GEOMETRY, DOMESTIC SCIENCE, RURAL SCIENCE, GARDENING, AND ENGLISH.

IRISH HISTORY. J. O'Neill Daunt—Chapters x-xiii inclusive. Christian Brothers' Irish History Reader.

ARITHMETIC—Four Primary Rules. Decimals and Fractions with simple problems thereon. Simple percentages (profit and loss). The Unitary System.

GEOGRAPHY—General—The Map of the World and Ireland; Special—Ireland's ancient and modern Divisions, Great Rivers, Harbours, Mountains, Towns, Bogs, Mines, Agricultural and other products.

AGRICULTURE—General—The Map of the World and Ireland; Special—Ireland's ancient and modern Divisions, Great Rivers, Harbours, Mountains, Towns, Bogs, Mines, Agricultural and other products.

DOMESTIC SCIENCE. (a) Preparation of simple and complex dishes; (b) Food and diet; (c) Sewing; (d) Washing and mending; (e) Preservation of food; (f) Home management; (g) Household accounts; (h) Simple arithmetic.

ENGLISH. (1) General—Elements of grammar; principles of the English language; composition; spelling; punctuation; and the use of the English language in writing; (2) English Literature; (3) English History.
