9	<i>Pterostylis allobula</i>		May – Dec No 'spout' between sepals
10	<i>Pterostylis trullifolia</i>		May- Dec Raised ridges on leaves. Has spout
11	<i>Pterostylis graminea</i> *		Aug-Dec Grass leaf Greenhood
12	<i>Corybas macranthus</i> *	<i>Nematoceras macrantha</i>	Aug-Nov
13	<i>Corybas orbiculata</i>		Aug-Oct. Short Tepals. Lip with rolled edges

15	<i>Corybas hatchii</i> *	<i>Nematoceras longipetala</i> <i>Corybas</i> 'Waiouru'	Sep-Nov Long Tepal Spider Orchid
16	<i>Corybas acuminatus</i>	<i>Nematoceras acuminata</i>	Sep-Dec spider orchid. Pointed hood and leaf.
17	<i>Caladenia chlorostyla</i> *	<i>C.</i> 'green stem'	Sep – Dec. No red hairs on stem or hood
18	<i>Caladenia bartletii</i> *	<i>C. carnea</i> , <i>C. catenata</i>	Sep-Nov bright pink,
19	<i>Earina mucronata</i> *		Sep-Jan. Epiphyte or terrestrial. Lip orange
20	<i>Earina aestivalis</i> *		Oct-Feb. Coastal Earina. Lip yellow
21	<i>Caladenia aff chlorostyla</i> *	<i>C.</i> 'red stem', <i>C. minor</i>	Oct – Dec. Red glands on stem and hood.
22	<i>Caladenia variegata</i>		Oct-Nov, pale pink mid lobe of lip yellow
23	<i>Calochilus paludosus</i>		Oct-Nov Bearded Orchid. No 'eye' glands
24	<i>Thelymitra ixiooides</i> *		Oct-Dec. Blue with spots. Column top reddish, pinched. Spotted Sun Orchid
25	<i>Thelymitra nervosa</i> *	= <i>Thelymitra decora</i>	Oct-Jan Blue with dk blue spots. Column top yellow & black Spotted Sun Orchid
26	<i>Pterostylis cernua</i> ?	as <i>Pterostylis aff paludosa</i>	Oct-Jan Pallid Bog Greenhood. Sparse
27	<i>Corybas oblongus</i> *	<i>Singularybas oblongus</i>	Oct-Dec. Little Spider Orchid.

28	<i>Corybas triloba</i> *	<i>Corybas ‘Remutaka’</i> <i>Nematoceras aff triloba</i>	Oct-Dec Spider orchid. Lip wings deep purple, Hood long, pointed and narrow
29	<i>Pterostylis banksii</i> *		Oct – Dec Common Greenhood
30	<i>Pterostylis foliata</i> *		Oct-Dec Rosette leaves, tall flower stem
31	<i>Pterostylis irsoniana</i>		Oct-Dec. Lip with recurved knob at end
32	<i>Pterostylis aff montana</i>		Oct-Dec. confused with <i>C. paludosa</i>
33	<i>Drymoanthus adversus</i> *		Oct-Dec Leaves usually plain, flower spotted
34	<i>Drymoanthus flavus</i>		Oct-Dec Leaves spotted, flower unspotted
35	<i>Microtis unifolia</i> *		Oct – Jan Lip frilly edged. Onion leaf Orchid
36	<i>Prasophyllum colensoi</i> *		Oct-Feb. Leek Orchid
37	<i>Microtis parva</i> *		Oct-Dec Lip plain , straight edged
38	<i>Chiloglottis cornuta</i>		Oct-Feb. Frog Orchid
39	<i>Thelymitra colensoi</i> *	<i>Thelymitra aff pauciflora</i>	Oct-Nov Column top golden brown
40	<i>Thelymitra pulchella</i> [1]*		Nov-Jan blue with dk blue stripes
41	<i>Thelymitra pulchella</i> [2]*		Nov-Jan white with blue stripes [locally rare]

43	<i>Bulbophyllum pygmaeum</i> *	<i>Ichthystomum pygmaeum</i>	Nov-Feb. epiphytic on kahikatea and rock
44	<i>Thelymitra x dentata</i> *	<i>T. pauciflora x T. pulchella</i>	Nov-Jan Bule with dk blue stripes Column top very warty
45	<i>Thelymitra hatchii</i> *		Nov-Jan. Lilac flowers, column-top horseshoe shaped. Leaf stiff, erect
46	<i>Pterostylis micromega</i> *		Nov-Jan. Flowers pale green, declining, rare
47	<i>Thelymitra pauciflora</i> *	includes several affs*	Nov-Jan 2-3 pale plain lilac to blue flowers Leaf narrow, channelled often red at base.
48	<i>Thelymitra longifolia</i> *	includes several affs*	Nov-Jan. Flower white, leaf us. broad strap affs. include bluish and lilac forms. Leaf narrow
49	<i>Thelymitra cyanea</i>	<i>Thelymitra venosa</i>	Nov-Mar. Blue/pink, with stripes. Column has twisted plain yellow arms
50	<i>Caladenia lyallii</i>		Nov. large white flower
51	<i>Corybas rivularis</i> agg	<i>Nematoceras rivularis</i> agg	Nov. at risk
52	<i>Dendrobium cunninghamii</i> *	= <i>Winika cunninghamii</i>	Dec-Jan. Bamboo Orchid
53	<i>Gastropodium cunninghamii</i> *		Dec – Jan column short, various colours
54	<i>Thelymitra formosa</i> *		Dec. Tall plant many flowers, column top red
55	<i>Pterostylis</i> sp.		Dec
56	<i>Pterostylis irwinnii</i> ?	<i>P. porrecta</i> ?	Dec
57	<i>Microtis oligantha</i>		Dec-Feb. Small, few flowers
58	<i>Gastropodium molloyi</i> *	<i>Gastropodium ‘long column’</i>	Dec – Feb. Lip yellow, column long
59	<i>Adenochilus gracilis</i>		Dec – Jan

Species	Formerly	Flowering times, comments
<i>Genoplesium pumilum</i>		Jan-Apr, like a single rush leaf
<i>Pterostylis alveata</i>		Feb-May, thick rolled sepal edge projects
<i>Corybas cheesemanii</i>		May-Sep, tiny leaf often under litter
<i>Cyrtostylis rotundifolia</i>		Jun-Aug, heart shaped leaf. Midge Orchid
<i>Corybas iridescens</i>		Aug-Oct, Dark purple lip,
<i>Pterostylis puberula</i>		Sep-Oct, very tiny, rosette of leaves
<i>Pterostylis tasmanica</i>		Sep-Oct, hairy mobile lip
<i>Corybas walliae</i>		Sep-Nov, green flowers
<i>Caladenia atradenia</i>		Sep-Nov, lip has chocolate calli
<i>Pterostylis cardiotigma</i>		Oct-Dec, nose up steeply
<i>Calochilus robertsonii</i>		Nov-Dec, Red Beard. Has 'eye' glands
<i>Gastrodia minor</i>		Nov-Jan, flowers often don't open
<i>Danhatchia australis</i> [under Nikau]		Dec-Feb, tiny pink leafless flower stem
<i>Gastrodia cooperae</i>	<i>Gastrodia 'long column black'</i>	Dec, dark tip to lip. Column long.
