


# *Cynoglossum virginianum*

Wild Comfrey

Family: Boraginaceae [Gleason and Cronquist 1991, Judd et al. 2007]

Other names: *Cynoglossum boreale*, *Cynoglossum virginianum* var. *boreale*

Notes: *Cynoglossum virginianum* is native in Indiana.



Corolla deeply 5-lobed, to 14 mm wide, pale blue; calyx deeply 5-lobed, to 4 mm long; stamens 5, included in corolla; ovary 1, 4-lobed, style 1. Blooms Apr 19–May 15.



Fruit of 4 grouped nutlets, to 0.8 cm.



Inflorescence to 20 cm.
