

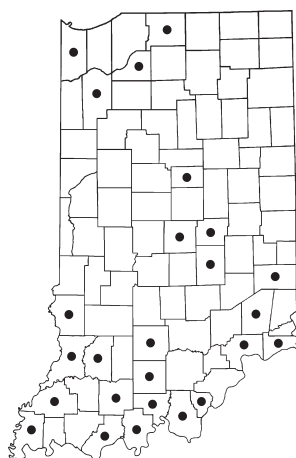
Planodes virginicum

Virginia Winged-Rockcress

Family: [Gleason and Cronquist 1991, Judd et al. 2007]

Other names: *Arabis virginica*,
Sibara virginica

Notes: *Planodes virginicum* is native in Indiana.



Petals 4, 2–3 mm, white; sepals 4, 1–2 mm; stamens 6; ovary 1. style 1. Blooms Mar 28–May 23.



Fruit (1–)1.5–2.5(–3.2) cm × 1–1.5 mm.

Leaves mostly basal and on lower stem, pinnately divided to the midrib or nearly so into (9–)13–25(–31) leaflets (or segments), the terminal one slightly larger than the lateral ones.



Annual or biennial herb to 0.4 m. Fallow fields, open disturbed areas.
