TASK 1

Part 1

There will be a big sale in the shopping mall close to the hotel you are staying in during your course in England. Write a short e-mail to your colleague from the course, in which you will inform him/her:

- about the sale;
- what you are interested in, and;
- how long the sale lasts.

Be sure to complete all the tasks above.

Suggested time: 10 minutes

Suggested length: 50 words.

Part 2

You have been to the shopping mall for the big sale. Write an e-mail to your friend in which you will:

- describe the shopping mall and the area around it;
- tell him/her how you spent your time there, and;
- give him/her detailed directions how to get from your hotel to the shopping mall.

Be sure to complete all the tasks above. Note that the intended reader is a friend of yours.

- express your belief that your problem will be solved.

How effectively can modern military forces adapt to fighting and working among civilian population.

Write an essay explaining your views and outlining ways in which the military can work together with civilian population to ensure success.

Note: You will not be rated on the actual accuracy of your opinions or suggestions. Only your ability to write and express yourself in English is being evaluated. Be sure to address each task and question.

- Speculate on how these new regulations might consequently affect developing countries.

Remember: You will be assessed on the content, organization, logical development, and complexity of your essay as well as richness and precision of your vocabulary and grammar, spelling and suitability for the intended reader.

Note that the intended reader is a well-educated native speaker.

Suggested length: approximately 300 words.
