### I. BUDDHISM (ALL SECTS)

#### Texts:

正藏經 v.1-55; 續藏經 v.56-85; 別卷 v.86-100 (圖像 12 v., 昭和法寶總目錄 3 v.) Over 3,000 titles of mainly Chinese texts.

Dai Nihon Bukkyo zensho. 大日本佛教全書 / Suzuki Gakujutsu Zaidan hen. 100 v. Tokyo: Kodansha hatsubai, 1970-1973.

本文 v. 1-96; 解題 v. 97-99; 目錄/索引 v.100. Covers 953 Japanese Buddhist texts printed by the end of the Edo period.

Fundamental annotated bibliography compiled by Ono Genmyo in 1933-36. V. 1-11: Japanese and Chinese Buddhist texts covering from the earliest times to 1932 containing 65,000 titles; v. 12-13: 73,000 titles published in 1932-1965; v. 14-15: supplement and indexes.

Butten nyumon jiten 仏典入門事典 / Daizokyo Gakujutsu Yogo Kenkyukai hen. 588 p. Kyoto: Nagata Bunshodo, 2001.

Part 1: Outline of Taisho shinshu daizokyo; Part 2: annotation of major 410 texts; Part 3: Biography of authors, translators, subject index, etc.

Butten kaidai jiten 仏典解題事典 / Mizuno Kogen. 452, 46 p. Tokyo: Shunjusha, 1977

Annotation of 319 Chinese, Indian, Tibetan, and Japanese texts and books.

Daizokyo zenkaisetsu daijiten 大藏經全解説大事典/ Kamata Shigeo hen. 1071 p. Tokyo: Yuzankaku Shuppan, 1998.

Explications of 2,920 texts in Taisho shinshu Daizokyo.

Nihon Bukkyo tenseki daijiten. 日本仏教典籍大事典. 551, 164 p. Tokyo: Yuzankaku, 1986

Contains signed articles of over 8,000 Buddhist texts from the earliest times

to 1868. Title, author, and subject indexes.

Kokusho somokuroku. 国書総目録 9 v. Tokyo: Iwanami Shoten, 1989-1991.

Nihon Bukkyo zenshu sosho shiryo soran. 日本仏教全集叢書資料総覧 3 v. Tokyo: Hon no Tomosha, 1986.

Provides tables of contents of 400 series and collected works published in 1868-1985. Volume 3 is an index.

Taisho shinshu Daizokyo mokuroku 大正新脩大蔵経目録 / Taisho Shinshu Daizokyo Kankokai hen. 171, 6 p. Tokyo: Taisho Shinshu Daizokyo Kankokai, 1969.

Taisho shinshu Daizokyo : Sakuin 大正新脩大蔵経索引 / Daizokyo Gakujutsu Yogo Kenkyukai. 45 v. in 49. Tokyo: Taisho shinshu Daizokyo Kankokai, 1962-1990.

**To locate Buddhist articles:**

Bukkyogaku kankei zasshi bunken soran 仏教学関係雑誌文献総覧 / Kokusho Kankokai hen. 4, 806, 104 p. Tokyo: Kokusho Kankokai, 1983.

Tables of contents of 288 Buddhist journals, bulletins, transactions, etc. dating from early Meiji to 1981. Author index.

Bukkyogaku kankei zasshi ronbun bunrui mokuroku 仏教学関係雑誌論文分類目録 / Ryukoku Daigaku Toshokan hen. Kyoto: Ryukoku Daigaku Shuppanbu, 1931-1986.

Classified catalog of Buddhist articles written from 1868 to 1983. Subject and author indexes. Articles written after 1983, consult bibliographies relating to particular Buddhist sects such as Shinshugaku kankei zasshi ronbun mokuroku.

Attempts to present Buddhism in various cultural phenomena. Historical maps and chronologies included.

Mochizuki Bukkyo daijiten. 望月佛教大辞典 10 v. Kyoto: Sekai Seiten Kanko Kyokai, 1955-1963.

Over 20,000 entries. Intended for Buddhist scholars to provide in depth knowledge in all phases of Buddhism. V.6: indexes in Sanskrit, Pali, Japanese and Chinese; V.7: chronology and genealogies; V. 8-10: supplements to the main section of v. 1-5.

Oda Bukkyo daijiten 織田佛教大辞典 / Oda Tokuno cho. 1874, 20, 118 p. Tokyo: Okura Shuppan, 1962.

35,000 entries. Old, but known for its scholarship. Source provided.

Nihon Bukkyo shi jiten 日本仏教史辞典 / Imaizumi Yoshio hen. 5, 1117, 112 p. Tokyo : Yoshikawa Kobunkan, 1999.

Buddhist terms and terms related to Japanese history, civilization, and culture extracted from Kokushi daijiten for the understanding of Buddhism. 47,000 signed articles with bibliographical references and illustrations throughout.

### Terms:

Kosetsu Bukkyogo daijiten 広説佛教語大辞典 / Nakamura Hajime. 4 v. Tokyo: Tokyo Shoseki, 2001.

53,000 Buddhist nouns extracted from early Buddhist texts in India, China, Japan, etc. Intended to explicate Buddhist terms in present day Japanese. Provides original text citations. V. 4: lists of original texts and indexes to Tibetan, Pali, Sanscrit, etc

Nihon Bukkyogo jiten 日本佛教語辞典/ Iwamoto Yutaka. 106, 856 p. Tokyo: Heibonsha, 1988.

Some 10,000 Buddhist terms and terms in classical literature relating to Buddhism are defined. Development of terms, usage, and the change of meanings are provided along with examples.

Reibun Bukkyogo daijiten 例文仏教語大辞典 / Ishida Mizumaro cho. 1147 p. Tokyo: Gakushu Kenkyusha, 1997.

30,000 terms collected from Buddhist texts as well as from historical and literary texts.

Zusetsu Bukkyogo daijiten 図説佛教語大辞典/ Nakamura Hajime. 760 p. Tokyo: Tokyo Shoseki, 1988.

Illustrated dictionary. Approximately 3,000 words and abstract concepts in Buddhism and Indian culture are presented in illustrations. Subject and original words indexes.

Contains over 15,000 words

Gyakubiki Bukkyogo jiten 逆引佛教語辞典/ Gyakubiki Bukkyogo Jiten Hensan Inikai. 296, 247 p. Tokyo : Kashiwa Shobo, 1995.

Contains over 47,000 words.

Nihon meisatsu daijiten 日本名刹大事典 / Tamamuro Fumio hen. 941, 48 p. Tokyo: Yuzankaku, 1992.

Important and outstanding temples of all sects from ancient times to the present totaling 5,000 are described. All entries signed.

Zenkoku jiin taikan : shichoson kubun ni yoru 全国寺院大鑑:市町村区分による/ Zenkoku Jiin Taikan Hensan Inikai. 3 v. Kyoto: Hozokan, 1991.

Directory of 780,000 temples of all sects. Arranged by district, then schools. V. 3: index arranged by temple names.

Explicates over 200 schools, their background, teachings. Entries also some 500 prominent individuals representing the sects.

Shinshu shinjiten 真宗新辞典 / Shinshu shinjiten hensanakai hen. 689 p. Kyoto: Hozokan, 1983.

Shin Jodoshu jiten 新浄土宗辞典 / Etani Ryukai kanshu ; Bukkyo Daigaku Bukkyo Bunka Kenkyujo hen. 943 p. Tokyo: Ryubunkan, 1978.

Mikkyo daijiten 密教大辞典 / Mikkyo Jiten Hensankai hen. 6 v. Kyoto: Hozokan, 1968-1970.

Shinpan Zengaku daijiten 新版禅学大辞典 / Zengaku Daijiten Hensanjo hen. 1328, 203, 87, 199 p. Tokyo: Taishukan Shoten, 1985.

### **Personal names:**

Nihon Bukkyo jinmei jiten 日本仏教人名辞典/ Nihon Bukkyo Jinmei Jiten Hensan Inkai. 887, 117 p. Kyoto: Hozokan, 1992.

Covers from ancient times to 1991, totaling 7,100 Buddhist priests and individuals in politics, philosophy, literature, arts, etc. with connections to Buddhism.

### **Chronology:**

Bukkyo nenpyo 仏教年表 / Saito Akitoshi. 649 p. Tokyo: Shin Jenbutsu Oraisha, 1994.

Part 1: Chronology of India, China, Japan; Part 2: Korea and Tibet.

Nihon Bukkyoshi nenpyo 日本仏教史年表/ Hiraoka Jokai, Tamamuro Fumio, Ikeda Eishun hen. 321 p. Tokyo: Yuzankaku Shuppan, 1999.

Incidents relating to Buddhism described chronologically up to 1911. First column: Buddhist matters; Second column: historical and social events.

### **Rituals, Observances, etc.:**

Bukkyo girei jiten 仏教儀礼辞典/ Fujii Masao. 373 p. Tokyo: Tokyodo Shuppan, 1977.

Approximately 100 entries related to Buddhist funerals and other functions.

Bukkyo gyoji girei shoshiki daijiten 仏教行事儀礼書式大事典/ Fujii Masao hen. 515 p. Tokyo: Yuzankaku, 1983.

Various Buddhist rituals.

### **Others:**

Bukkyo bungaku jiten 仏教文学辞典 / Takeishi Akio, Suganuma Akira hen. 347 p. Tokyo: Tokyodo Shuppan, 1980.

Terms relating to Buddhist literature, names of authors and works.

Bukkyo hiyu reiwa jiten 仏教比喻例話辞典 / Mori Shoji hen. 643 p. Tokyo: Tokyodo Shuppan, 1987.

Buddhist concepts and thoughts described in allegories.

Bukkyo ongaku jiten 仏教音楽辞典 / Amano Denchu. 508, 60 p. Kyoto: Hozokan, 1995.

3,300 entries. Traditional ceremonial music and modern Buddhist music.

## II. SHINTO

### Texts

Shinto taikei. 神道大系 / Shinto Taikei Hensankai. 120 v. Tokyo: Shinto Taikei Hensankai, 1978-1994. Zoku Shinto taikei. 続神道大系. 18 v. 1995-2001.

Collection of Shinto and Shinto related works, divided into several sections: koten-hen, ronsetsu-hen, jinja-hen, jingu-hen, etc.

### Bibliographies

Shinto shoseki mokuroku = A bibliography of Shinto 神道書籍目録 / Meiji Seitoku Kinen Gakkai ; daihyo Kato Genchi. 646 p. Tokyo : Meiji Seitoku Kinen Gakkai : Dobunkan, 1943. Meiji Taisho Showa Shinto shoseki mokuroku = A bibliography of Shinto 明治 大正昭和 神道書籍目録 / Kato Genchi hen. 707 p. Tokyo: Meiji Jingu Shamusho, 1953.

The 1943 edition covers titles published from the earliest times to 1868, and the 1953 edition covers 1868-1940. 16,000 works divided into 10 categories.

Shinto bunrui somokuroku 神道分類総目録 / Saeki Ariyoshi hen. 652, 104, 93 p. Tokyo: Meicho Fukyukai, 1988.

Lists Shinto books and books useful for studying Shinto, totaling 10,000 titles. Covers publications up to 1911 divided into 13 categories.

Shinto ronbun somokuroku 神道論文総目録 / Kokugakuin Daigaku Nihon Bunka Kenkyujo hen. 755 p. Tokyo: Meiji Jingu Shamusho, 1963. Zoku Shinto ronbun somokuroku 続神道論文総目録 / Kokugakuin Daigaku Nihon Bunka Kenkyujo hen. 947 p. Tokyo: Daiichi Shobo , 1989.

The 1963 edition covers articles in journals published 1868-62. The later edition covers 1962-1986. Shinto related articles in scholarly journals selected and arranged by subject and author.

Shinto jinbutsu kenkyu bunken mokuroku 神道人物研究文献目録 / Kokugakuin Daigaku Nihon Bunka Kenkyujo hen. 737 p Tokyo: Kobundo, 2000.

About 2,000 authors deceased by 1996 are entered with brief biographies and a list of their works. Citations provided when authors are cited elsewhere.

Old, but comprehensive.

Shinto jiten 神道辞典 / Anzu Motohiko, Umeda Yoshihiko kanshu. 666, 60 p.  
Osaka: Horii Shoten, 1968.

Approximately 2,400 entries divided into four categories: shrines, personal names, books, and general. Signed articles with bibliographical references.

Shinto jiten 神道事典 / Kokugakuin Daigaku Nihon Bunka Kenkyujo hen. 830 p.  
Tokyo: Kobundo, 1994.

Divided into nine sections: gods, systems, shrines, festivals, beliefs, etc. Signed articles and illustrations throughout. Supplement; lists of shrines, gods, bibliography, and chronology.

Shinto chronology covering from the earliest times to 1967.

Over 4,000 gods' names listed.

Biographical dictionary containing 4,000 Shinto related people from the earliest times to 1945.

Shinsosai sogo daijiten 神葬祭総合大事典 / Reiten Kenkyukai hen. 631p. Tokyo:

Shinto funeral rites.

Brief description of approximately 2,000 shrines.

1962.

Lists 6,000 shrines, arranged by prefecture. Each prefecture contains an index.

Zenkoku jinja daiyoran. 全国神社大要覧 538 p. Tokyo: Ritchi Maindo, 1989.  
217 shrines, arranged by prefecture.

### III. POPULAR RELIGION

#### Dictionaries, General:

Minkan shinko jiten 民間信仰辞典 / Sakurai Tokutaro hen. 345 p. Tokyo: Tokyodo Shuppan, 1980.

700 terms related to folk beliefs. Signed articles and bibliography at the end.

Nihon minzoku shukyo jiten 日本民俗宗教辞典/ Ikegami Yoshimasa hen. 658 p. Tokyo: Tokyodo Shuppan, 1998.

Presents Japanese religious attitudes. Approximately 800 entries, signed with bibliographical references.

Nihon shukyo jiten 日本宗教事典 / Ono Yasuhiro hen. 949, 47 p. Tokyo: Kobundo, 1985.

Divided into chapters such as origins of religious culture, Taoism, Confucianism, shugendo, new religions, etc. Chapters further subdivided and followed by explications.

#### Dictionaries, Gods:

Nihon jingi yurai jiten 日本神祇由来事典 / Kawaguchi Kenji hencho. 510, 48 p. Tokyo: Kashiwa Shobo, 1993.

Origin and history of about 2,000 Shinto gods and folk gods explained. Includes genealogy of Japanese mythology.

Nihon no shinbutsu no jiten 日本の神仏の辞典 / Oshima Tatehiko hen. 1364 p. Tokyo: Taishukan Shoten, 2001.

About 19,000 religious objects of people worship.

#### Dictionary, Illustrated:

Nihon shukyo minzoku zuten 日本宗教民俗図典 / Hagiwara Hidesaburo, Suto Isao. 3 v. Kyoto: Hozokan, 1985.

Divided into 18 categories. Provides people's belief objects and practices in photographs.



#### IV. NEW RELIGION

Shinshukyo jiten 新宗教辞典 / Matsuno Junko hen. 489 p. Tokyo: Tokyodo Shuppan, 1984.

Describes about 200 new religious groups; their origin, teachings, gods, writings, activities, bibliographies, etc.

Shinshukyo jiten 新宗教事典/ Inoue Nobutaka . 1147 p., 64 p. Tokyo: Kobundo, 1990.

Part 1: analyzes and describes religious groups in chapters such as origin and development, founders, organizations, teachings, practices, etc. Part 2: Directories of over 300 new religions, also bibliographies, chronology, etc.

Shinshukyo kyodan, jinbutsu jiten 新宗教教団人物事典 / Inoue Nobutaka henshu. 804 p.

Tokyo: Kobundo, 1996.

Revised and enlarged edition of the above title, Part 2.

Dare mo ga ki ni naru shinshukyo bunpa seiryoku chizu

だれもが気になる新宗教分派勢力 地図 / Aoyama Nakaba. 287 p. Tokyo: Besuto Bukku, 1996.

108 new religions in six groups:世界平和系、宇宙系、人類愛系、修行系、神仏合一系、その他. Questionnaires are filled in on topics such as reasons for starting religions, its teachings, philosophy, history, catch phrases, profiles, etc.

#### V. CHRISTIANITY

Nihon Kirisutokyo rekishi daijiten 日本キリスト教歴史大事典 / Nihon Kirisutokyo Rekishi Daijiten Henshu Inkai hen. 1734 p. Tokyo: Kyobunkan, 1988.

Intended to cover the entire Japanese Christian church history. Over 10,000 signed entries with bibliographies.

Nihon Kirisutokyo shi nenpyo 日本キリスト教史年表 / Nihon Kirisutokyo Rekishi Daijiten Henshu Inkai hen. 91 p. Tokyo: Kyobunkan, 1988.

Chronology of Christianity in Japan, 1490 - 1982. Five sections: World, Catholics, Greek Orthodox, Protestant, and Japan in general.

Sekai Nihon Kirisutokyo bungaku jiten 世界日本キリスト教文学事典/ Endo Tasuku. 772 p. Tokyo: Kyobunkan, 1994.

Deals with literature related to Christianity in Japan and the world, focusing on literary authors and their works. Signed articles with bibliographies.

Nihon Kirisutokyo bunken mokuroku : Meiji-ki ; part II (1859-1912)

日本キリスト教文献 目録 明治期 / Kokusai Kirisutokyo Daigaku Ajia Bunka Kenkyu Inkai hen. 429, 62 p. Tokyo: Kokusai Kirisutokyo Daigaku, 1965.

Approximately 1,000 books related to Christianity and books published under the influence of Christianity, printed in 1858-1912. Arranged by subjects.
