

Glass Block Mortar Mix

Description

Pakmix[®] Glass Block Mortar Mix is a high strength, custom blended, white mortar designed to provide a decorative, waterproof joint. It may also be used for other purposes that call for a white mortar. The product is a blend of high quality white Portland cement, hydrated lime, specially graded fine aggregates, and other proprietary ingredients. Pakmix[®] Glass Block Mortar Mix exceeds ASTM C-270 for Type S Mortar.

Suggested Uses

- Glass block dividing walls for interior and exterior applications
- Window replacements
- Any application requiring a high quality white mortar

Preparation

Clean the surface and remove all loose material, oil, grease, and foreign matter. Prepare glass blocks according to the manufacturer's recommendations.

Directions for Mixing

Add clean, potable water to the dry mortar and mix to an even consistency. Remember that a stiffer consistency, using less water, is required as compared with normal masonry blocks, since glass blocks absorb no water.

Note: For additional waterproofing ability and greater strength, replace half of the mixing water with Pakmix® Cement Fortifier.

Items You May Need

- Safety glasses
- Rubber gloves
- Joint spacers
- Mortar box or wheelbarrow
- Bucket of water and sponge
- Trowel
- Acrylic jointer

Packaging and Yields

Packaged in 50 lb. bags and will lay approximately:

- 36 6" x 6" Blocks
- 32 8" x 8" Blocks
- 18 12" x 12" Blocks





For Best Results

Apply the mortar with a brick trowel using a full bed of mortar with no furrowing. Follow the block manufacturer's instructions. Joints should be tooled with an acrylic jointer and clean blocks with a sponge and water after the mortar has set up (hardened) enough to keep them in place. Air and material temperatures should be above 40° F for proper setting.

Clean Up

Clean up is simple and easy with soap and water. Clean the tools before the material hardens.
