


Plant Characteristics for Graham's Penstemon


- Perennial herb

- Ascending-growing upward and curved







Leaves

- 3-18 mm wide
- Thick
- Entire (rarely with few teeth)
- Glabrous






Shape basal (bottom) leaves ovate, broadly oblong










Inflorescence

- Pink/purple with yellow stamen

















Stems



- Upper leaves 4-10 cm long 3-10 mm wide




Shape of basal (bottom) leaves

Tapering/winged base






Shape of upper leaves




Inflorescence

- Blue/lavender








Habitat
