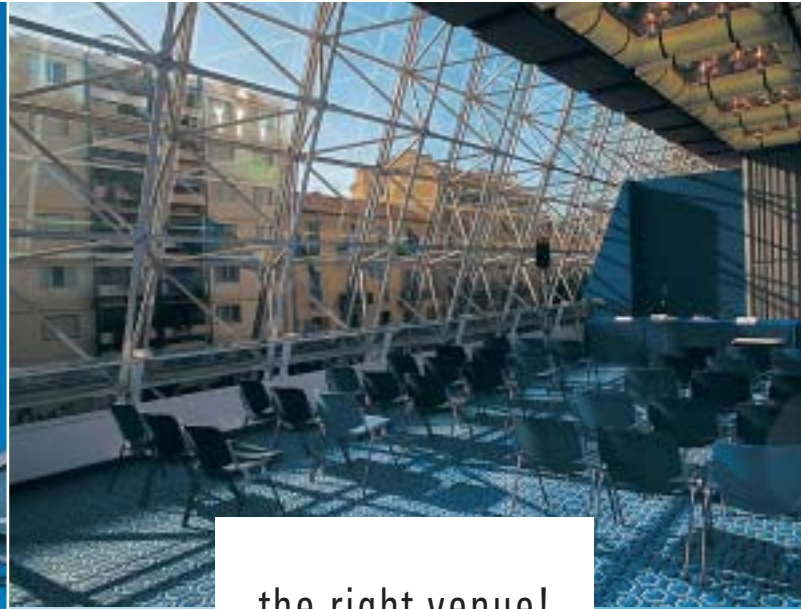

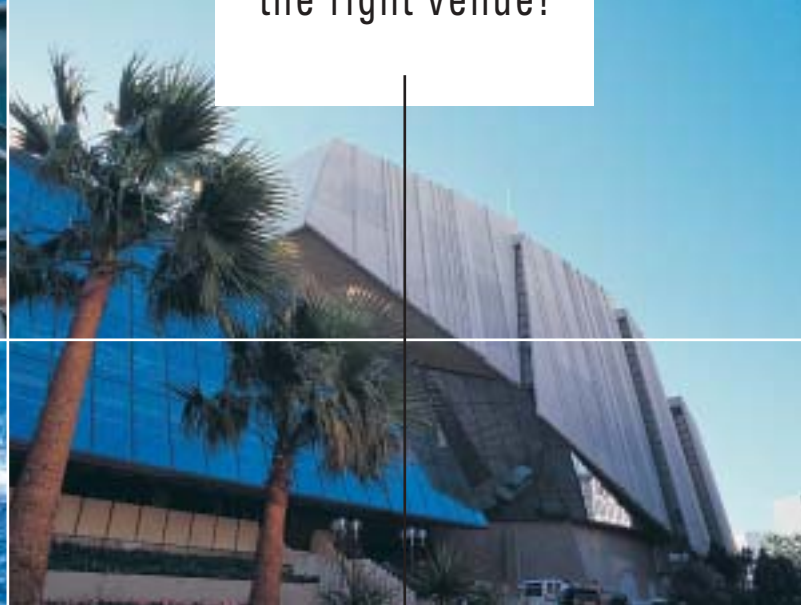

DESTINATION NICE

SITUATION



Located in southern Europe at the southeastern extremity of France, Nice is a privileged crossroads between the Alps, Provence, Corsica and Italy. The city occupies an exceptional natural site in the heart of the French Riviera. It stretches over a coastal plain open southward onto the Mediterranean and bounded from East to West by a succession of wooded hills. In the background rise the first peaks of the Alpine foothills, some reaching over 9000 ft above sea level, only 31 miles from the coast as the crow flies...

Nice enjoys an exceptional microclimate that has contributed to its renown for some two centuries. Open onto the sea, the city is protected from the winds by its hills, then, to the west, by the Estérel mountains and to the northwest by the barrier of the Mercantour Alps. The climate is always mild in winter and never too hot in summer, thanks to the sea breeze. You can often lunch on a terrace with no more than a T-shirt in February, when the rest of France is shivering in the cold.

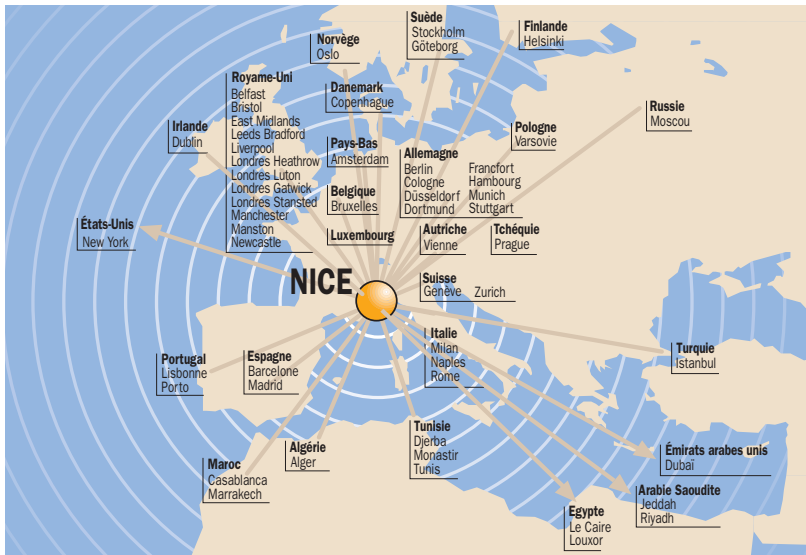

Built on the sea, the airport is less than 15 minutes from the heart of Nice and its hotels.

As the gateway to the French Riviera, Nice Côte d'Azur Airport is at the heart of economic growth in the Alpes-Maritimes. This undeniably modern and secure business entity plays an active role in the development and the harmony of the department. But today more than ever, thanks to its infrastructures, the impact of France's second airport extends well beyond the borders of the region.

Flying from Nice, passengers have the choice of 41 scheduled airlines, 70 destinations and 23 countries. Each and every day, Nice offers links to major European cities, North Africa, the Middle East and North America.



For a spot of work in between flights, or for your meetings, general assemblies or training sessions, we can offer:

- **at terminal 1:**
 - 5 20m² offices for up to 6 people - 1 70m² office for up to 12 people
 - 1 room of 240m² for up to 250 people, which can be divided into two rooms of 120m² or 4 measuring 60m².

TOURIST ROUTES

Route Napoléon (RN 85)

This historic route connects Golfe-Juan with Grenoble via Digne, Sisteron, Castellane and Grasse. From Cannes, follow the coastal road.

Highway RN7

From the west, drive through Fréjus, Saint-Raphaël and Cannes. From the Italian border, towards Menton, Monaco and Èze (Moyenne Corniche).

Roya gorges (RN 204)

From Italy (Turin, Cuneo) and Col de Tende, drive to Sospel then Menton before taking the coastal road (or Basse Corniche).

Var valley (RN 202)

From Saint-André-les-Alpes, drive to Nice via Entrevaux and Puget-Théniers.

Route des Grandes Alpes

From Thonon-les-Bains on Lake Geneva in Savoy, this route goes through the main Alpine passes, 4,500 to 8,400 ft above sea level (remember some passes are closed from mid-October to early June). From Menton, follow the coastal road.

Located in the heart of the city, the Port of Nice is made up of a 10 hectares basin, 7 hectares of platforms and some ten wharves, six of them commercial. It is located 4 miles from the Nice Côte d'Azur International Airport and a few minutes on foot from the city's main tourist attractions (Old Nice, Place Masséna, shopping areas, Nice-Acropolis conference and exhibition Centre...).

YACHTING



The Port of Nice has 500 mooring berths, including 24 for large yachts and can accommodate units over 75 ft long.

The following services are available:

- mooring on floating decks, catways, wharves;
- fuel: by lorry;
- electricity: 220 or 380 V;
- drinking water;
- telephone, cable TV;
- daily weather forecasts;
- showers, toilets;
- slipway, launderettes, distribution of ice.

CRUISES

As home port, for transit and excursions, Nice-Villefranche was the top French port for cruises in 2000, with more than 180,000 passengers: 55 cruise ships, chartered by some forty major companies, made 285 stopovers. (Nice is a member of the "Med Cruises" Association grouping the largest Mediterranean cruising ports.)

The Convention and Visitors Bureau and the Management of the Port of Nice provide free hospitality information for cruise ships on arrival and departure.

MARITIME CONNECTIONS BETWEEN NICE AND CORSICA

With 2,000 rotations and over 760,000 passengers, the Port of Nice became in 2000 the second port for ferries to Corsica. With this walking tour, visitors can discover the lively atmosphere of the most picturesque neighbourhood in Nice and enjoy strolling through its colourful markets. It provides a fine occasion to visit the 17th and 18th-century Baroque churches and discover splendid polychrome façades on the way.

This tour, between the Port and Place Masséna, takes approximately 2 hours, plus the time to visit the churches and Palais Lascaris.

Follow **Cours Saleya** (polychrome façades, flower market, fruit and vegetable market, chapelle de la Miséricorde), then turn left on **Rue Jules-Gilly** (Red Penitents' chapel). Continue on **Rue Droite** (Jesuit church, or église du Gesù), before reaching, to your left, **Place Rossetti** (Sainte-Réparate cathedral).

Return to **Rue Droite** (Palais Lascaris) towards **Place Saint-François** (fish market).

«THE BELLE ÉPOQUE IN NICE»



The Arcades

By the end of the 18th century, English and Russian aristocrats flocked to Nice. This theme tour takes visitors in the footsteps of the city's winter visitors of the "Belle Époque".

The tour starts in the **Mont-Boron district (map L5)** which boasts several remarkable villas. Among the elegant homes overlooking the sea, there is the striking "**Château de l'Anglais**", with its Orientalist inspiration, pink façade and crenellated tower.

Then proceed to the **hill of Cimiez (map K2)** where the English colony built luxury residences like the **Régina Palace** and **Grand Hôtel Victoria**. Nearby, in the park of **Château Valrose**, former home of Baron Van der Wies, is an amazing wooden isba from Siberia.

Returning to the city centre, go to **Saint Nicholas' Russian Orthodox cathedral (map H3)**. The tsarina

Maria Feoderovna built a chapel here in memory of her son, the Grand Duke Nicholas. The church is a splendid example of Russian religious architecture (visit recommended, see p. 17).

Continue westward to discover the **Jules-Chéret Fine Arts Museum (map G4)** in a former private home that once belonged to the Ukrainian Princess Kotschoubey (visit to the museum, see p. 16). Nearby there is another typical Belle-Époque "folly", **château des Ollières**.

Return to the centre of town on Promenade des Anglais and the **Hôtel Négresco**, a listed historic monument typical of the luxury hotels of the Belle Époque.

Acquired by the City of Nice in 1942, it was classed as an Historical Monument in 1946. Influenced by the Genoese baroque style, the palace combines a 17th-century ensemble with embellish-

ments and modifications from the 18th century. The buildings are organised around two small inner courtyards from which a monumental stairway leads off through arched bays. The vault in the entrance vestibule bears the coat of arms of the Lascaris-Vintimille family. State apartments occupy the first floor in each of the two wings of the building. The ceilings in this series of rooms are either decorated with frescoes on mythological themes or with stucco dating from the end of the 17th century. An apothecary founded in 1738 was set up on the ground floor. Rooms on the 3rd floor will soon harbour the City of Nice's collection of antique musical instruments.

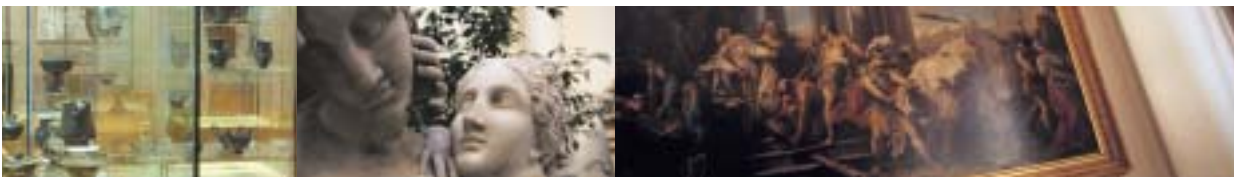

Espace Masséna opens a broad perspective on the old town and hills. It is made up of a central basin of 1,500 m² with spectacular waterworks and flower-covered pergolas. 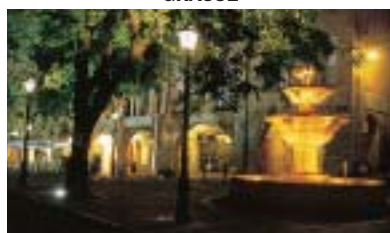

ROYA AND BÉVÉRA VALLEYS

To the northeast of Nice, the gorges of the Roya-Bévéra rivers reach the Mercantour National Park, near the site of Vallée des Merveilles. Sospel occupies a privileged position, between the sea and the mountains. The road then rises all the way to Tende, the last town before the Italian border. The tunnel under Col de Tende is at an altitude of 3900 ft above sea level and leads to Cuneo and Turin in Italy.

Sights:

- Saorge, a spectacular semicircular mountain village.
- Breil-sur-Roya (Écomusée du Haut-Pays 'ecomuseum').
- Historic organs: there are seven instruments by the greatest organ builders of Tuscany and Lombardy in the valley. Perfectly restored, they are now listed historic monuments.

Over the 3 passes: from Nice over Col de Nice, then over Col de Braus towards Sospel. Then it continues towards Tende over Col de Brouis, and through the towns of Breil-sur-Roya and Saint-Dalmas-de-Tende.

Variant: take Motorway A8 to Menton, then up to Sospel via Col de Castillon (tunnel or pass). Then, from Sospel, same as above.

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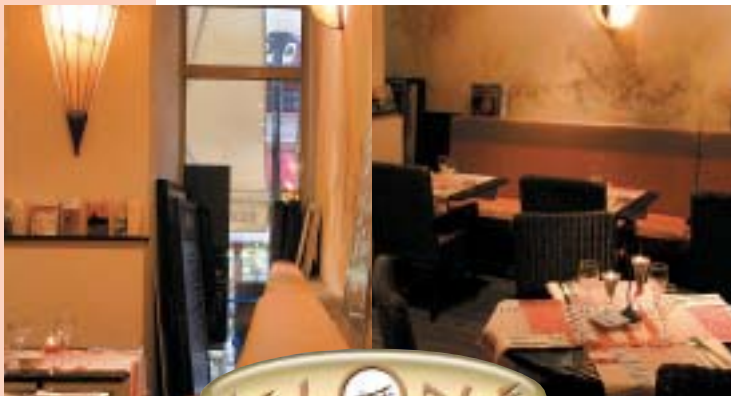
