 Exiled Haitian President Jean-Bertrand Aristide, speaking at the Saturday luncheon, described his homeland as the poorest in the Western hemisphere in material goods but "rich in terms of human values." He asked ADC members for assistance in lobbying Congress for financial aid to retrain the Haitian armed forces as a law-abiding and law-enforcing entity, and in addressing the medical, ecological and economic crises facing Haiti. Bosnia was discussed throughout the conference. During the Friday luncheon, Saffet Abid Catovic, deputy director of special affairs at the Embassy of Bosnia and Herzegovina to the United Nations, called the goal of Bosnian Serb aggression against Bosnian Muslims "extermination of a nation and the extermination of the idea of peaceful coexistence in the region. " He told the Arab-American audience, "You understand what it means to be denied an identity, " and drew a parallel between the pan- Serbian movement drive for a "Greater Serbia" and the struggle of the Zionist movement for "Eretz Israel. " At the Saturday night banquet, ADC founder James Abourezk stated, "Although the words 'ethnic cleansing' were invented during the Serbian onslaught against Bosnia, the act of ethnic cleansing was invented by the Israelis in 1948, when they drove as many Palestinians out of Palestine as they could to make Israel a majority Jewish state."

The Bosnian Muslims, through Fatih's Third World Relief Agency (TWRA), began smuggling arms for their cause in 1992. American sources suspect that Sheikh Omah Abdel Rahman, the radical imam who was convicted of organizing the terrorist attack on the World Trade Centre in New York in 1993 had several links to TWRA. Another terrorist with strong links with TWRA is Osama bin Laden, who tops the most wanted terrorist list in the United States. Several Bosnian Muslims have direct ties with TWRA, including: Irfan Ljevakovic, a founder of the Stranka Demokratske Akcije (SDA-Alija Izetbegovic's ruling Bosnian Muslim party), the Bosnian Muslim political wing and the man responsible for bringing mujahadeens to Bosnia-Herzegovina; Alija Izetbegovic, SDA and Bosnian Muslim president who guaranteed Fatih's credentials to the Die Erste Osterreich Bank (Austria), enabling him to open an account there. The Bosnian Muslims used the bank account to solicit and transit funds for arms purchases. Other Bosnian Muslims listed as Executive Directors of TWRA include: Hasan Gencic, Husein Zivalj (deputy foreign minister of Bosnia-Herzegovina), and Faris Nanic (an advisor of Alija Izetbegovic). Such ties between "humanitarian organizations" and terrorists are nothing new when in comes to the Balkans. At the same time, a segment of the media reluctantly reported that the Bosnian Muslim authorities issued a passport to Osama bin Laden himself. The passport was issued in the Bosnian embassy in Vienna, Austria, in 1993.

FBI Arrests Head of Chicago-Based International Charity Organization Charges include perjury relating to alleged terrorist activity The head of an international charitable organization in the Chicago area has been arrested on charges of , perjury "for allegedly lying in Federal Court documents about links to international terrorism," according to a statement from the office of the U.S. Attorney of the Northern District of Illinois April 30. Syrian-born naturalized U.S. citizen, **Enaam M. Arnaout**, the executive director of Benevolence International Foundation (BIF), an international charity organization based in Palas Hills, 111., was arrested on April 30 in his home in south suburban Justice, said the statement.U.S. Attorney Patrick Fitzgerald charged that Amaout had ties with Usama Bin Laden, and BIF provided logistical support to al Qaeda, the statement said.

**"FBI raid two Muslim charity groups"**  
 BRIDGEVIEW, Ill. (AP) -Two suburban Chicago Muslim organizations denied links to terrorism after government officials raided their offices searching for evidence. **The Global Relief Foundation in Bridgeview and the Benevolence International Foundation** in Palas Hills were searched Friday, FBI spokeswoman Ebony Hanel said. Another search was conducted Friday at a Benevolence International Foundation office in Newark, N.J., according to Dean Boyd, spokesman for the U.S. Customs Service "If they're investigating terrorism, they're not going to find anything here," said Roger Simmons, an attorney for Global Relief. Whatever the government is doing "is a trible, trible, trible, tragic mistake," he said. Representatives of the Benevolence International Foundation did not return phone calls rom The Associated Press on Saturday, but a recorded message encouraged callers to donate to a fond for pOOT Muslims, including Afghan war refugees. On Friday, a **spokesman for the group Saffet A. Catovic** said the charity is cooperating. ' 'It's part of a higher level of scrutiny of all Muslim relief
