THE INEXPRESSIBLE MYSTERY

The God of the universe is mysterious. Science has not been able to solve the mystery of how the universe came into being or explain exactly what continues to give it creative energy and masterful design. No religion asserts that it has found words to name fully the ineffable mystery of God, for no matter what name we use, God always transcends our limited ability to understand. God is a mystery to be believed, not known. And yet, we Christians believe that our name for God best expresses that inexpressible mystery: God is the Most Holy Trinity of three persons united in a communion of love, pouring forth that creative, saving, sanctifying love into the world. Today's scriptures celebrate the mystery of the Trinity and give us clues for living that mystery in our lives.



From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

Today is Holy Trinity Sunday. The doctrine of the Most Blessed Trinity is not just some abstract dogma about God. God has graciously chosen to reveal the mystery of His inner nature to us in and through the person and teachings of Jesus Christ, the incarnate Son of God, who regularly prayed to God as Father, and who also sent His Spirit to abide with us. But for us Christians, the Trinity is not an abstract theological concept but a reality that is to be lived through, one that shapes our relationships to God and each other. The Holy Trinity is a Community of love. The Catechism teaches that "by sending His only Son and the Spirit of Love in the fullness of time, God has revealed His innermost secret: God Himself is an eternal exchange of love, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, and He has destined us to share in that exchange". Therefore, it is also a statement about us; in Baptism we received the indwelling of the Blessed Trinity. "The complete Trinity dwells in us". By worshiping the Trinity, we realize the full truth of ourselves. "In the communion of grace with the Trinity, man's living area is broadened and raised up to the supernatural level of divine life. Man lives in God and by God." While it is important to know about God, it is more important to know God; therefore, today is a celebration that we can know something fundamental about God: God knows us and loves us, and God wants us to know it. God loves us so much that He has made Himself available to us throughout history and that He continues in this desire to have a relationship with us.

We are individuals in loving relationships in a community of people possessed by God because we are made in God's image. This brings us to the question, how do we experience love? How do we know what love looks and feels like? We know love because we are loved and love others. Through community interaction with others, we experience love. The Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit are a community of love and dwell at the core of all Christian Life. May the love of God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit continue to pour out in our hearts and be the center of our lives.

This time of year we begin to hear the end of school bells! Graduation time surrounds us. Already, some of our young men and women of the parish have graduated from colleges and universities. Congratulations on their achievements.

This past week we saw our high school students celebrate their baccalaureate Masses and commencement exercises. The Parish extends congratulations and best wishes to these high school graduates.

Registration for CCD 2017-2018 school year is under way. You may register at the Rectory Monday-Friday, between 9:00AM and 3:00PM.

The following is required for Registration:

- 1) Completed Registration Form
- 2) Signed copy of "**Appendix A**" from the Handbook
- 3) Baptismal certificate for all new registrations (only if your child was **not baptized** at Stella Maris)
- 4) Signed letter of permission from your pastor (only if you are **not** a member of Stella Maris Parish)
- 5) Registration fee of \$175 per child for parishioners and \$200 per child for non-parishioners of Stella Maris

Please note: CCD classes are held on Sunday mornings.

PROPERTY TAX REBATE

To help with the rising cost of living, you are reminded that **Pennsylvania Property Tax/Rent Rebate Program** applications are now available. There are new guidelines which will permit individuals that **qualify to receive a rebate between \$250 and \$650 from property taxes or rent paid last year**. Funding for this rebate program is made possible by the Pennsylvania State Lottery Fund and is a rebate that does not have to be repaid. **This application must be filed by June 30, 2017**. To qualify, you must be 65 years of age or older, a widow or widower 50 years of age or older, or a disabled person 18 years or older. Homeowners that have annual incomes of \$36,663 or less and renters with annual incomes of \$15,713 or less could qualify. **Only half of your annual Social Security or SSI income is counted toward the income guideline**.
