# HISTORICAL SKETCH

Thetford Academy was established in 1819 by a group of Thetford men, who felt strongly that formal education beyond the primary grades should be available to the town's children. The original founders numbered 15, and included such well-known names of the time as Rev. Asa Burton, Judge Jedediah Buckingham, Simeon Short, and Timothy Bartholomew. From the beginning, Thetford Academy was co-educational: this being attributed to the number of educated and strong-minded women living in Thetford at the time, who likely influenced their husbands toward admitting girls to the school from the beginning.

For most of its history, the Academy operated as a boarding school for out-of-town students, as well as the secondary school for Thetford Students. In 1894, state legislation required that towns over 2,500 in population must pay tuition to secondary schools. Though Thetford's population was considerably less than the 2,500 threshold, the Town began paying the Academy that same year. In 1906, state legislation was passed that required all towns to financially support their schools, thus establishing a 'free education' system, and eliminating privately paid tuition.

A devastating fire in 1942 destroyed five buildings on Thetford Hill, including three belonging to the Academy. Then Principal Carl Anderson faced the daunting task of housing existing students while scrambling for classroom space. The campus as it looks today is a result of both the need to rebuild following the fire, and a larger student population. The fire eventually brought about the end of boarding students, though the Academy continues to take non-Thetford students on a tuition basis. The school currently serves grades 7 - 12, and is the oldest secondary school in Vermont.
