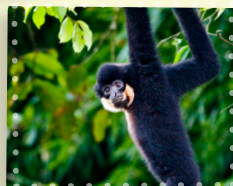
## About our tours

## A typical day of Wildtour Birding

In the mid-day, we have picnic lunch at a nice spot for birding but sometimes, especially at the hot climate areas, we return to hotel for a short rest then go out in late afternoon. Before or after dinner, we meet as a group to record daily checklist, discuss what we saw and plan for the next day. Some evenings we do owling or night safari for owls, nightjars and frogmouths.
