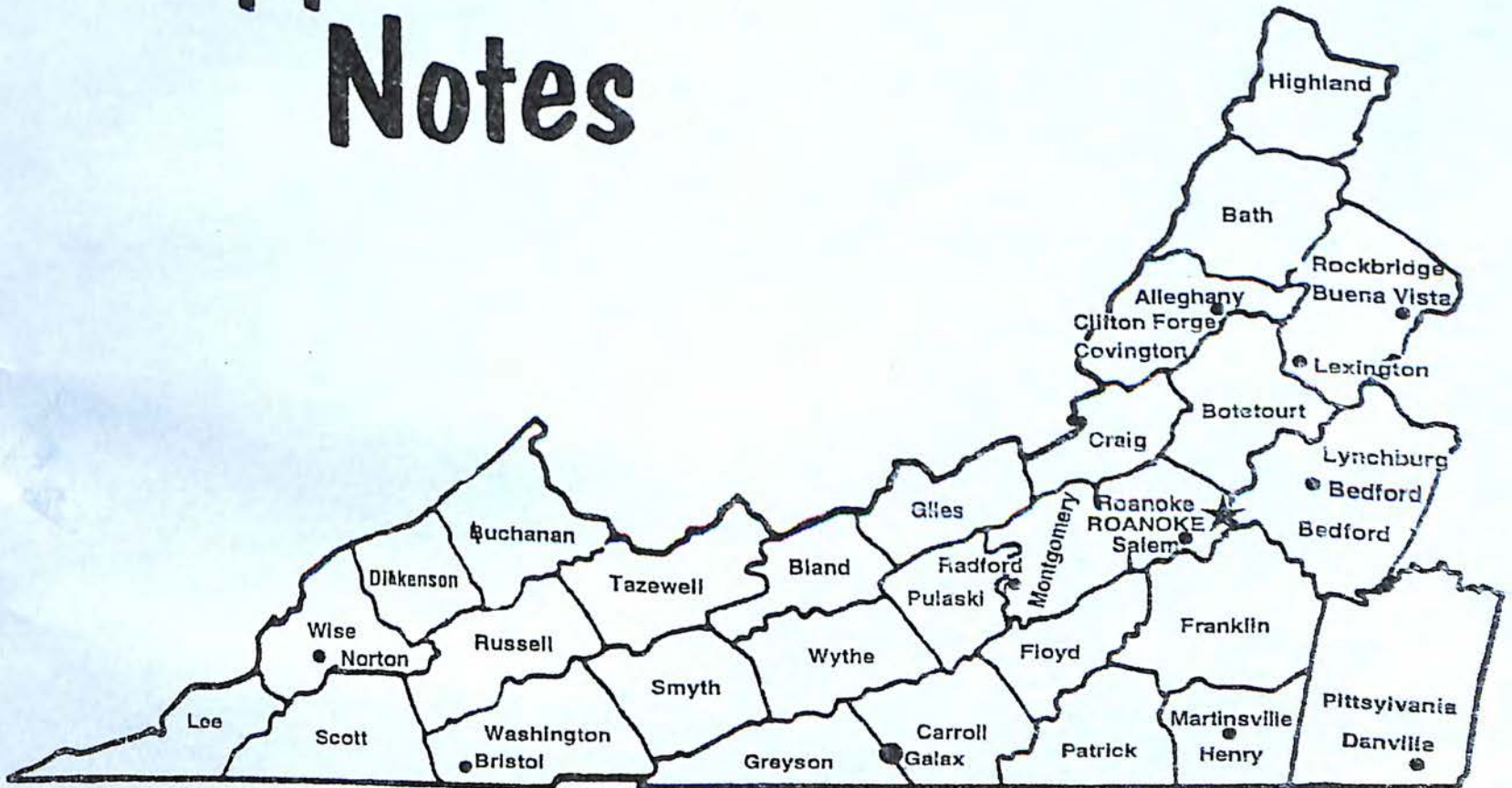

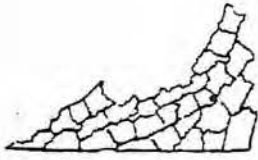

Dear Fellow Members,

This issue marks the beginning of the 2002 VAN. For those of you who have not paid your 2002 dues this will be your last issue! For your convenience there is a renewal form on the last page of this issue. Also, there are still a few copies of Charles T. Burton's book, **Botetourt County, Virginia, Early Settlers** left. An order blank is provided for your convenience.

I hope you all had happy holiday season. Perhaps you had a chance to talk with family members and pick up some new information. In my case, I discovered that I could easily order the military records of my great uncle who served in WWI with the Canadian Expeditionary Forces. They are available at the Canadian National Archives in Ottawa, Canada. He is a "mystery". He eventually left his home and family, never to be heard from again. The records, at least, give a glimpse at a special period in his life.

In April the 1930 US census will be released. Some of us will be lucky. The state they are interested in has a Soundex. Others, like myself, won't be so lucky. Only 10 states and portions of two other were Soundexed. Enter Stephen Morse and friends. He created the website to help find people in Ellis Island passenger lists and now he has one to help locate the correct Enumeration District in larger US cities. You need to know the street where you expect to find the family. Plugging in the street name will give you the ED number or numbers. Clicking on the numbers will tell you other streets in the ED. Hopefully, this information will narrow your search area. I'll be excited to try it after the April release. The site can be found at:

1780]. [Griffin Gartin was his brother].

Applied for pension 1832, Monroe Co., Va. married, 1784, Anne _____ at Hagerstown, she b. 1766 applied for widows pension 1842. Served from Berkley Co., Va. 1778-1779, 1781. Served in Fort Lawrence, Ohio, Yorktown. [came to Monroe Co., Va. soon after the War.]

BOTETOURT COUNTY, VIRGINIA,
EARLY SETTLERS

By Charles T. Burton

Throughout southwestern Virginia, Charles T. Burton was a well known and respected genealogist and historian who compiled a large amount of data. The Southwestern Virginia Genealogical Society is pleased to announce the publication of Charles T. Burton's work, *Botetourt County, Virginia Early Settlers*. In this compilation he confined his presentation to the 1782 land area of Botetourt County. In that year the indicated area encompassed all or portions of: Monroe county, West Virginia and the present day Virginia counties of Montgomery, Floyd, Giles, Roanoke, Craig, Allegheny and Bath. During his many years of researching, he collected material relating to the 1740 to 1795 land transactions of the early settlers in the indicated area. This compilation was his attempt to index this material. Approximately 2000 individuals are listed alphabetically by their surname and then their given name. These entries are followed by an identification of the county where the record is located, along with the type of record, its book, page, date, and quite often the acreage and location of the land.

This compilation consists of 133 pages of names. It has a soft cover and a cloth binding. Only a small number of copies have been printed and, unless the demand exceeds our expectations, we will not republish it. It is an excellent resource for use in identifying many of the early settlers and in locating most of their early documents that relate to the 1782 Botetourt land area.. Purchase information is on the order blank.

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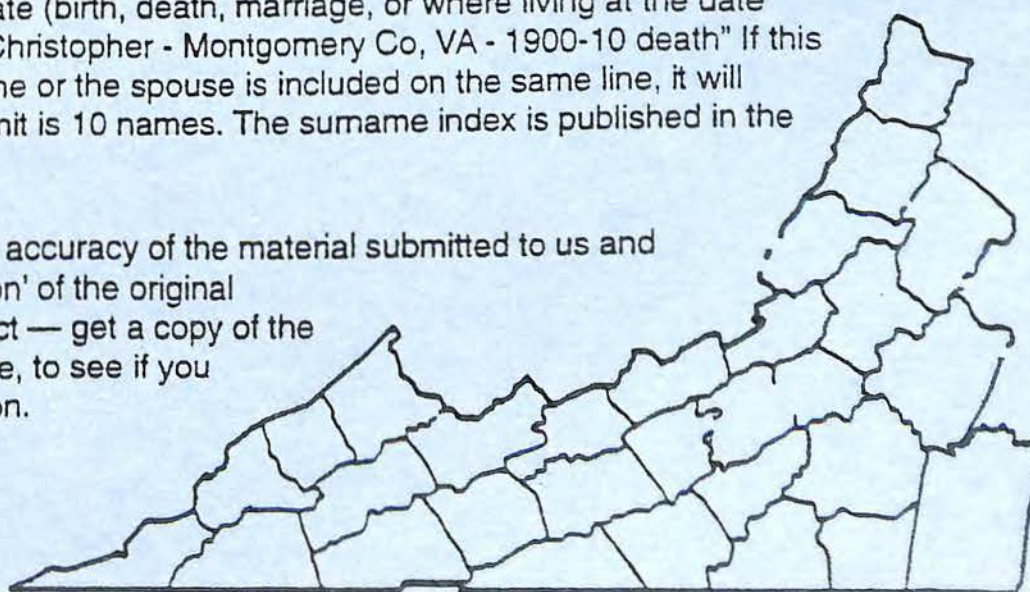
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
