acmodontum ('Sweet Leilani' x self) – (Philippines) Colorful and easy species with mottled leaves. available. 3.5" pots \$35



WSO 4430 amabile ('Charles' AM/AOS x sib) – (Indonesia) This is the real amabile, not what has been recently sold in the trade. Exquisite foliage and charming flowers on tall inflorescences. Makes a great specimen! Rare in cultivation. 2.5" pot, 3-4" ls Seedlings \$25



WSO 4381 barbatum ('Poe Valley' AM/AOS x self) - (Malaysia)

Grows quickly into compact specimen plants. Grow intermediate with moderate light. Some of these are already beginning to bloom. Limited. 3.5" pot BS Seedlings \$25



WSO 5591 barbigerum album ('North Fork' HCC/AOS x

'Kelly Creek' HCC/AOS) - (China) Fast-growing seedlings of this lovely yellow and green form of a super cute miniature species. 2.5" pot 3-4" Is Seedlings \$30



WSO 5045 braemii ('Woodstream' HCCAOS x self) –

(Indonesia) Compact growing and still rare species related to tonsum. Very limited. 2.5" pot \$25



WSO 4804 bullenianum – (Malaysia) Tall stemmed beauty with beautiful mottled leaves. Still rare in cultivation. 2.5" pot \$25



callosum ('Select x sib) – (Thailand, Malaysia) Getting rare in cultivation. 2.5" pot \$25



WSO 4525 callosum var. sublaeve – (Thailand, Malaysia) 5 available. 2.5" pot, 3-4" Is Seedlings \$15; 3.5" pots NBS Seedlings \$25



charlesworthii ('No Reflexing' HCC/AOS x *frma sandowiae*) – (Myanmar) Always amazing species with huge pink dorsal sepal. 10 available 3.5" pots 1-2 growths \$35



WSO 3339 *dayanum* ('LASCA' x self) - (Borneo) Rare in cultivation beautiful graceful flowers. 1 available 3-4" LS Seedlings \$25; 1 available, NBS Seedling 3.5" pots \$40



WSO 5325 *druryi* ('Floradise' HCC/AOS x 'The King' AM/AOS) – Unusual and rare Indian species, that is probably close to extinction in the wild. 2.5" pot 3-4" ls seedlings \$20 each



druryi ('Ray' HCC/AOS x self) – (India) A good quality selfing of this unique and beautiful Indian species. 4 available 3.5" pots 1-2 growths \$35



WSO 4784 exul ('Penns Creek' x self) – (Thailand) See image above. Not yet awarded, but a distinct possibility. Very large flower. Grows well in slightly higher light. 1 available. 2.5" pots 3-4" Is Seedlings \$20



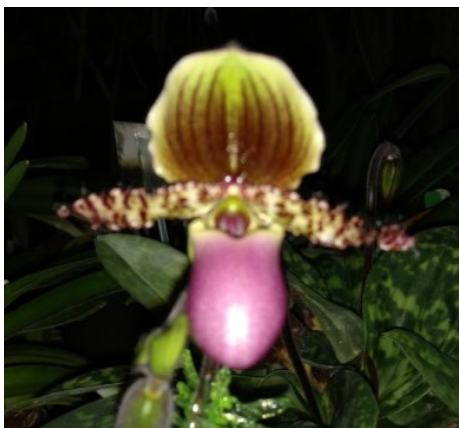
fairrieanum ('Pinotage' AM/AOS x 'Fred 300') – (India) Outstanding grex using Orchid Zone-bred parents 10 available 3.5" pots 5" BS Seedlings \$40



WSO 4803 fowliei - (Philippines) Limited release of this now rare in cultivation tiny miniature Paph will bloom on very small plants. Stays small. Limited. 2.5" pot, 3-4" ls BS seedlings, \$25 each



Paphiopedilum gigantifolium ('MH-3 SM/TPS x self) – (Indonesia)
Terrific selfing from Taiwan of one of the most unusual and rare Paphs. 6 available 3.5" pots 12" LS Seedlings \$85



WSO 5295 Paph glaucophyllum ('Sterrettania' AM/AOS x 'Tongue River' AM/AOS) – (Sumatra) Vigorous and beautiful sequential bloomer that is in bloom for much of the year. Easy. 2.5" pots 3-4" ls Seedlings, \$15 each

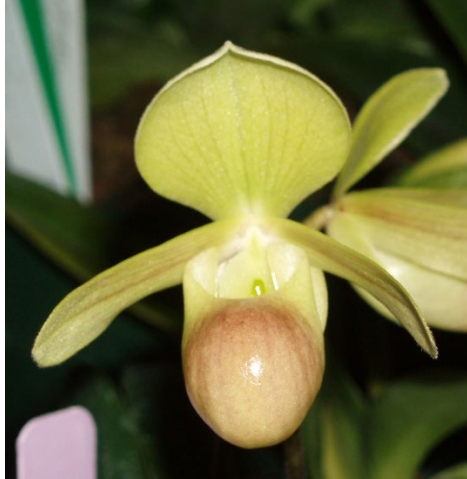
Cypripedium gratixianum var. *daoense* – (China) Lovely compact

Paphiopedilum helenae 'Rullands Coulee Creek' - (China) Divisions of our best *Paphiopedilum helenae*. A beautiful miniature species. 3.5" pots 1 available. BS Divisions \$45



Paphiopedilum hennisianum album – (Philippines) Rare albino form of this charming and worthwhile species. Easy to grow. Very limited. 3.5" pots BS Divisions \$45



Paphiopedilum henryanum – (China) terrific compact-growing sib cross of this charming species. 2.5" pot 3-4" Is Seedlings \$25; 3.5" pots BS Divisions \$35



henryanum v. christae – (China) Spectacularly lovely and exceedingly rare suffused color-form of henryanum. Solid light green dorsal without spots. Pink pouch. One just received an AM/AOS. Few to be released. 3.5" pot NBS Seedlings \$300



javanicum ('Pinkotee' x self) – (Indonesia) 20 years ago these were available by the dozen. Now they are rare in cultivation. 3.5" pots BS Seedlings \$35



lawrenceanum ('Jack' HCC/AOS x sib) – (Borneo) A key species in the background of many Maudiae-type hybrids that is now all but lost from cultivation. Tall stems and beautiful mottled foliage. Very limited. 3.5" pots NBS Seedlings \$45



lawrenceanum var. hyeatum ('Sparkling' x self) – (Borneo)

A key species for making green hybrids that is now all but lost from cultivation. Very limited. 3.5" pots NBS Seedlings \$45



WSO 4751 liemianum ('Kelly Creek' AM/AOS x 'Penns

Creek' AM/AOS) – (Indonesia) A perennial favorite! Beautiful sequential blooming species that can be in bloom for months (or longer). Very limited. 2.5" pot 4" Is Seedlings \$20; 3.5" pots NBS Seedlings \$35



malipoense – (China)) Lovely flowers on tall stems. One of

the few fragrant Paphs. Very limited. 3.5" pot 4-5" Is Seedlings \$40



moquettianum ('Yang-Yi AM/AOS x sib) – (Sumatra)

Another beautiful sequential bloomer that is getting rare in cultivation. First to bloom of this cross received an AM/AS. Very limited. 3.5" pot NBS Seedlings \$35; 4.5" pots BS Seedlings \$45



niveum ('Pinot Blanc' x 'Champagne') – (Thailand) Lovely

white Brachypetalum species that is easy to grow and bloom. Slightly fragrant. 10 available. 3.5" pot BS Seedlings \$35



philippinense 'Mohawk' – (Philippines) A really nice

cultivar of philippinense var. philippinense. Very compact growing plant with large flowers and great color. Very limited. 3.5" pots NBS Divisions \$40



Paphiopedilum rothschildianum ('Gold Star' SM/TOGA x Mont Milais' FCC/AOS,RHS) - (Borneo) King of Paph species. A great cross from Taiwan. 3.5-4.5" pots 12" Is Seedlings \$50



WSO 2958 *Paphiopedilum spicerianum* ('Lick Run' x 'Penns Creek') - (India)
Hugely popular easy to grow fall-blooming species with long-lasting flowers. The parents are siblings from a cross we received from Holland with very large flowers! Actually, this is the best quality grex of this species we have seen, and that is saying something. 2.5" pot 4-5" Is Seedlings \$15; 3.5" pot NBS Seedlings \$30



WSO 5328 superbiens ('Skyline' AM/AOS x sib) – (Indonesia) Mating two superior clones of the "Darth Vader" of Paph species. 'Skyline is from the original Orchid Zone sib cross (we received 4 AM/AOS from that batch). As beautiful as they are sinister. Terrific foliage. 2.5" pots 3-4" Is Seedlings \$20



WSO 5386 tranlienianum ('Weitas Creek' HCC/AOS x 'Minion 12301' AM/AOS) – Unusual miniature Chinese species looks like nothing else. 3-4" Is Seedlings \$25



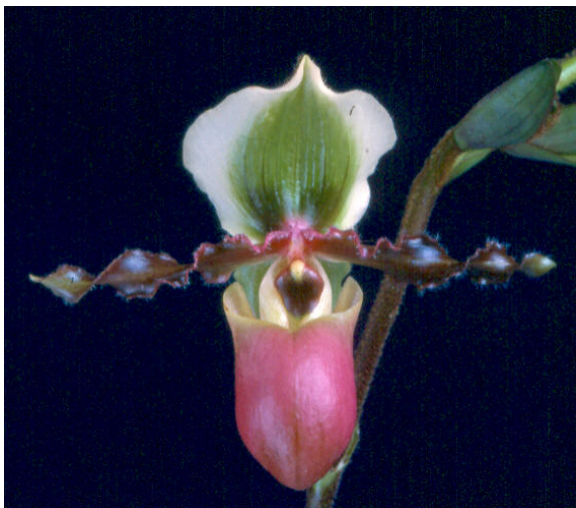

WSO 4749 victoria-reginae ('Savage River' AM/AOS x 'Benner Springs') – (Indonesia) Everyone should have this species in their collection. Large colorful sequential bloomer that can be in bloom literally for years! 2.5" pot 3-4" Is Seedlings \$25; 3.5" pot 5-7" Is Seedlings \$35



villosum ('Gigantea' x 'Expansion') – (India) Vigorous blooming size multi-growth seedlings of this colorful long-lasting Himalayan species. One received an AM/AOS. 4.5" pot BS Divisions \$35



villosum forma aureum ('Yellow Holiday' x self) – (India) Vigorous blooming size multi-growth seedlings of this glorious form of villosum. 3.5" pot BS Divisions \$65



wenshanense ('Fine Spots' x 'Wow')– (China) Full yellow flowers with purple spotting. Wow is what we said when the first ones bloomed. Easy. 3.5" pot NBS Seedlings \$35



WSO 4236 wolterianum ('Maybrook' HCC/AOS x sib) (Cambodia) - Beautiful seedlings with attractive foliage and brightly colored flowers on tall stems. Grow quickly into compact specimen plants. Getting rare in cultivation. Grow intermediate with moderate light. Limited. 3.5" pot BS Seedling \$25

mooreana 'Penns Creek' – (Panama) tall branching spikes of beautiful 1 inch green flowers with magenta lips. Easy. 3.5-4.45" pot BS Divisions \$35

WSO 5561 melanoporphyreum – (Peru) Terrific species with reddish foliage and black-purple flowers on branching panicles. Moderate light. Starts blooming small. 2.5 pots Seedlings \$15; 3.5 pots BS Seedlings \$25



Miracle Valley 'Nodesh Ka' – A really cool, very compact reed stem Epi. 3.5" pot, BS Divisions \$20



parkinsonianum – (Mexico-Panama)

Incredible and unique Epi that is easy to grow and bloom. Highly fragrant (won the Fragrance Competition) at the New York International Orchid Show. 3.5 pot, NBS Division \$35; 6" pots BS Divisions \$50 (may require special long box and extra shipping fee)

polyanthum – (Mexico) Easy to grow. Rare in cultivation. 3.5-4.5" pots BS Divisions \$20



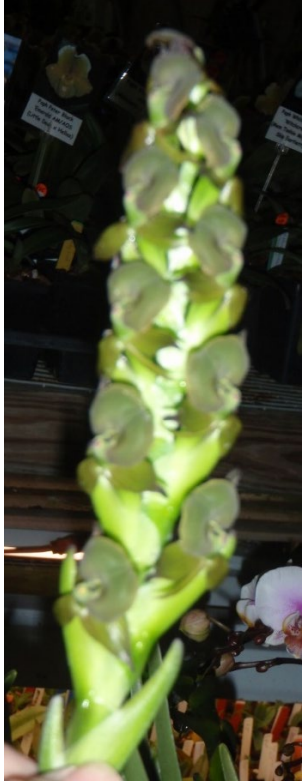

We receive orders frequently and at busy times and during the show season, they can accumulate quickly. During these times, we do check our e-mail and it is easier for us to respond. - New Ordering Information - To place an order please send us an e-mail with the plants listed you wish to order. We will confirm availability via return we-mail and at that point will request shipping address and payment information. Credit card orders will be taken over the phone (410-610-6697). We will be glad to call you to get your credit card information.
- First come, first served. We strongly recommend making a reservation, well in advance, to prevent disappointment. As availability of some crosses or species may be limited, we welcome all inquiries concerning availability. Often there are more seedlings or flasks of sold-out items "on the way'.

- After your order has been confirmed and "picked", we will e-mail an order confirmation to you. Please include your e-mail address in any correspondence. WE ACCEPT CREDIT AND DEBIT CARDS (VISA, MASTERCARD, AMERICAN EXPRESS AND DISCOVER) and continue to accept checks or money orders, made payable to "Woodstream Orchids". **You may call Bill's cell phone: 410-610-6697 to provide credit card information.** PLEASE PROVIDE DESIRED SHIP-TO ADDRESS.

- NO FOREIGN PLANT ORDERS AT THIS TIME! FLASKS ONLY

- As soon as possible, after receiving payment, we will pack and ship your order. Orders will be shipped in the order they are received, weather-permitting. We try to avoid shipping during periods of extreme hot and cold (either in your area or ours). There may be a significant delay during the busy show seasons (March - June, October - November).

- Plants may be shipped bare root or in pot. Especially large plants may be shipped bare root to protect the plants and reduce shipping cost. We recommend that plants be removed from flasks and shipped in insulated protective packing (domestic sales only). We will ship plants in flask but plants may experience some jumbling in transit.

- For domestic shipping via US Priority Mail, please include \$15 for orders under \$100 to be shipped to the eastern US and \$20 for orders shipped to the west coast. Due to increases in postal rates, we have had to increase our shipping fees. Especially heavy shipments of flasks or plants in pot or large boxes (that are charged a balloon rate) will be billed at cost.

- We guarantee safe shipping. From December 15 until March 15, only if Express Mail Service or FedEx Standard Overnight Shipping is used. These charges range from \$24-50, or more, depending on weight and box dimensions.

- Plants may be returned within 5 working days if not satisfied.
