The Research Associate will develop and manage the Foundation's

The Research Associate will have primary responsibility in developing, managing, analyzing, and reporting on databases related to various categories of fast growing African businesses across the continent. In addition, the Research Associate determines, recommends, and structures the appropriate method of research to investigate specific business issues or problems and provides inputs towards solutions for the African private sector. He/she designs research projects to collect information for use in the identification and analysis of program solutions. The Research Associate also works with third-party research vendors to assist in identifying the best approaches. The Associate designs research studies and programs to enhance the Foundation's competitive positioning in providing tangible solutions for the African private sector.

The position is based in Lagos, Nigeria and reports to the Foundation CEO.

- ➤ **Primary Research:** Conducting in-depth primary research using the range of methods, ability to develop a range of research methods surveys, focus groups, gather exploratory and specific data, strong interviewing and communications skills and can engage with stakeholders from various cultures, in addition to analyzing results and turning them into actionable inputs and outcomes
- Writing: Contributing to the Foundation's publication and articles based on findings of the research
