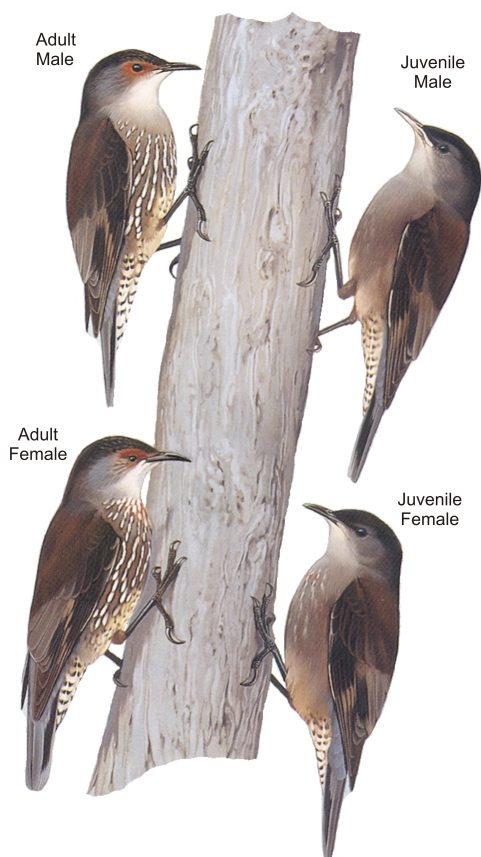


Red-browed Treecreeper *Climacteris erythrops* Species No.: 560 Band size: 03 (04)



Morphometrics:

	Adult Male	Adult Female
THL:	37.9 – 39.7 mm	37.8 – 38.3 mm
Wing:	81 – 89 mm	81 – 87 mm
Tail:	55 – 66 mm	58 – 66 mm
Weight:	20 – 30 g	20 – 26 g

Ageing:

Juveniles attain most adult plumage within two months of fledging, but may retain juvenile-like bill and pale gape until second year.

	Adult (2+)	Immature (1) or (2-)
Bill:	black;	grey with cream rami, or cream with slate grey culmen ridge and slate-grey tip to upper mandible;
Gape:	black;	yellowish or cream;

Only one moult per year;
No immature plumage recorded.

Sexing :

	Adult Male	Adult Female
Upper breast:	brownish-grey;	centre of upper breast white with broad rufous-brown streaking;
Supercilium:	broad, rufous-brown extending beyond eye into ear coverts;	dark red-brown does not extend beyond back of eye;

Incubation by female only.
