

Ageing:

Juveniles attain most adult plumage within two months of fledging, but may retain juvenile-like bill and pale gape until second year.

Adult (2+) Immature (1) or (2-)

Bill: grey with cream rami, or cream with slate grey

culmen ridge and slate-grey tip to upper mandible;

Gape: black; yellowish or cream;

Only one moult per year;

No immature plumage recorded.

Sexing:

Upper breast: brownish-grey; centre of upper breast white with broad

rufous-brown streaking;

Supercilium: broad, rufous-brown extending dark red-brown does not extend beyond

beyond eye into ear coverts; back of eye;

Incubation by female only.
