

Uppertail P.p. punctatus - rufous, rufous, but some lack red rufous-brown

Immatures retain all juvenile remiges and often rectrices;

Moult to adult plumage commences at approximately one year of age. So adults are aged (2+) and immatures (2-) or (1) depending on time of year and condition of plumage; Both sexes develop brood patches.
