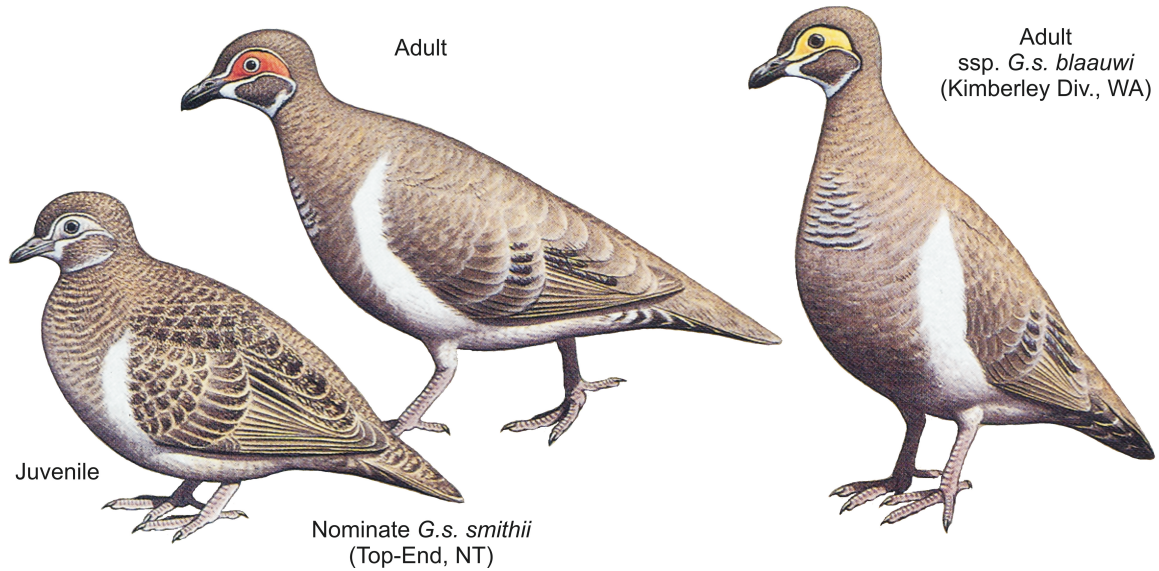


Partridge Pigeon *Geophaps smithii* **Species No.: 40** **Band size: 09 (Trial)**

Ageing:

	Adult (1+)	Juvenile
Bill:	black;	horn with darker tip;
Iris:	variable - white to pale grey, pale green pale yellow, mauve or brown;	brown;
Facial skin:	<i>smithii</i> – mostly red, but varies from pink-red to orange-red; <i>blaauwi</i> – yellow;	like adult, but duller;
Legs & feet:	horn;	pale pink;

Adult plumage is attained in the first year. Thus age adults (1+).

Sexing:

There is no sexual dimorphism in size or plumage;
Incubation by both sexes.
