

Ageing:

Adult breeding (2+) Juvenile / Immature Adult non-breeding (2+) Bill: bright red to crimson with olive-black often with red dark olive brown; bright yellow tip; tinge grading to dull yellow

tip;

Iris: red-brown; dull red-brown; dark brown;

Legs & feet: front of tarsus & top of toes wholly olive-green to yellow; dark olive-green or olive

orange-red to orange, rest -brown;

dark olive-grey;

olive-yellow, lime green or

uniform grey-black;

top of head dark brown, grey-black;

rest grey-brown;

Chin & throat: grey-black; grey with white feather grey-black; bases often visible:

Juveniles moult to an immature plumage that is similar to adult non-breeding plumage, but juvenile tertials and remiges and some body feathers are retained. Adult plumage attained early in the second year so age adults (2+).

Sexing:

Head & neck:

Plumage of both sexes is similar throughout life, but adult males may be marginally larger than adult

All members of the group are thought to assist with incubation.
