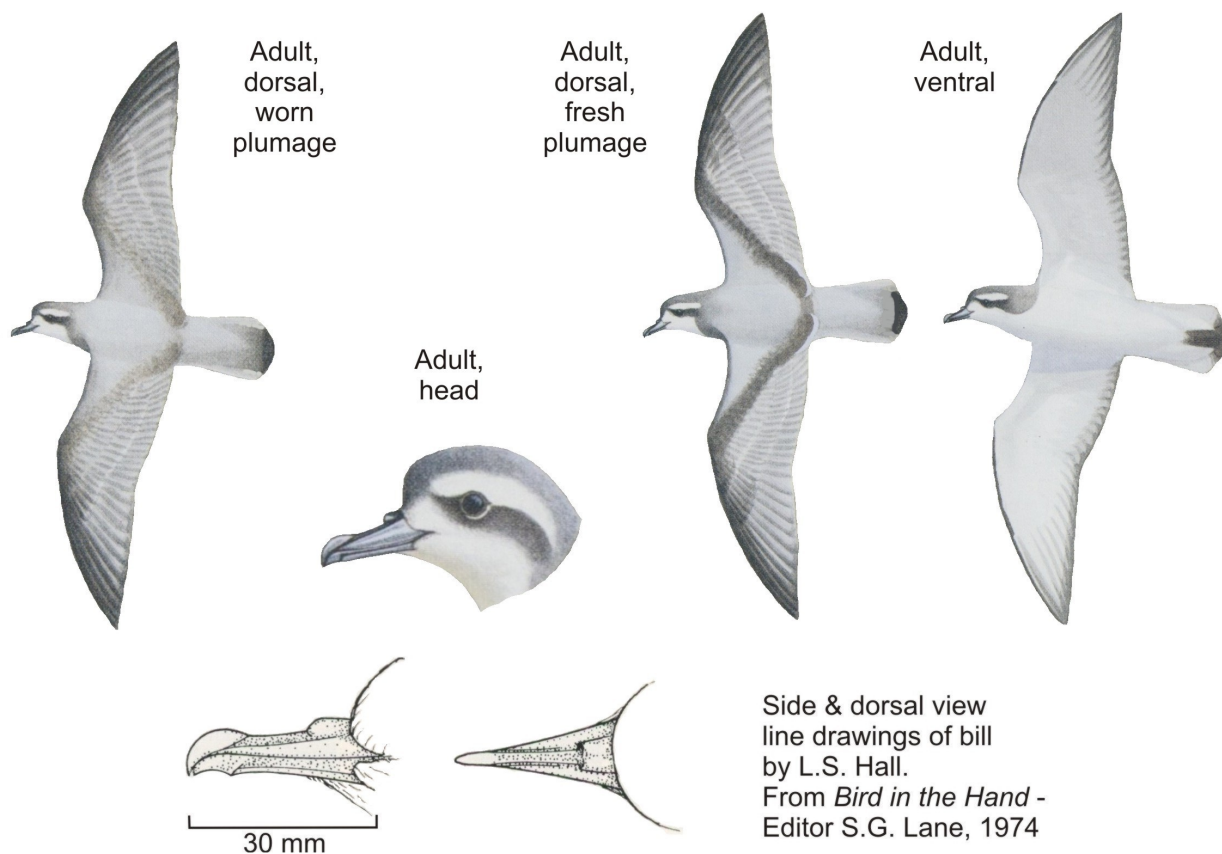


Slender-billed Prion *Pachyptila belcheri* Species No.: 942 Band size: (trial) IN



Identification:

Narrow terminal black-brown band on tail t1 to t3, whole of t4 to t6 are light grey;
Length and width of bill (see illustrations above).

Morphometrics:

Weight:		118 – 180 g

Ageing:

Juveniles (1) depart nesting burrows mid March for at least two years;
Juveniles have high culmen, greater bill depth and soft latericorn which distinguishes them from adults;
Age at first breeding is not known. Breeding birds will be at least (3+).

Sexing:

No sexual dimorphism in size or plumage;
Females sexed on distension of abdomen during breeding season;
Both sexes incubate.
