Eczematous Rash

Superficial dermatitis e.g. tinea



Papular Rash

Small raised and solid area of the skin, usually occurring in clusters. Do not contain pus.



Petechial Rash

Tiny flat purple or red spots ranging in size from pinpoint to less than 2mm. Does not blanch.

<u>NOTE: Potential</u> meningococcal rash



Erythematous Rash

Redness and inflammation of the skin. Blanches under pressure.



Papular Urticarial Rash

Raised and itchy patches on the skin e.g. insect bites



Purpuric Rash

Purple or red blotches on the skin. Blotches greater 2 mm to 1 cm in diameter.

<u>NOTE: Potential</u> meningococcal rash

Pustular Rash

Small raised and solid area of the skin filled with pus.



Urticarial Rash

Raised red blotches, welts or weals



Vesicular Rash

Raised areas of the skin filled with5 fluid e.g. blister, chicken pox.
