[Abronia latifolia Yellow Sand Verbena](#)

A flat to mounding nearly non-frost tolerant perennial that will 'disappear' to the roots under stress. According to Parsons "The stout root . . . is sometimes eaten. The flowers are ... [Learn more.](#)



[Abronia maritima Sand verbena](#)

A flat nearly non-frost tolerant perennial that will 'disappear' to the roots under stress. The flowers are pink and it grows in the sand along the immediate coastline. It loses an... [Learn more.](#)



[Abronia umbellata Purple Sand Verbena](#)

Beach Sand Verbena is a prostrate perennial, with slightly succulent leaves, and attractive rose colored flowers with white centers. It makes a good ground cover in coastal areas. I... [Learn more.](#)



[Achillea millefolium arenicola](#)

A perennial that grows right next to the ocean, on bluffs or the coastal sand spits. The consistent variable seems to be the sea salt spray keeps the plants a low height of 2 inch... [Learn more.](#)



[Achillea millefolium californica Yarrow](#)

Western Yarrow is a small perennial that spreads by rhizomes. It varies by locale from 1-4'. The cream-colored (off-white?) flowers are in 3- 4" clusters. It's native to the coastal strand. It is drought... [Learn more.](#)

[Astragalus nuttallii Nuttall's Milkvetch](#)

[Atriplex californica Saltbush](#)

A gray perennial, with scurfy leaves, prostrate, spreading, good as groundcover, in sandy, coastal areas, at seaside, flowers insignificant, birds and small mammals also useful... [Learn more.](#)



[Atriplex canescens Four-wing Salt Bush](#)

Four-wing Salt Bush is an evergray shrub that grows to 5 ft. Native to dry areas, western U.S. Needs full sun. It becomes very drought tolerant after a few good waterings. The leaves are edible (y... [Learn more.](#)

Beach Saltbush grows along the coast in sandy areas next to the bay, or along the high tide line of sheltered inlets. It's native from about Ft. Bragg to Baja. Very small and low it can

[Baccharis pilularis pilularis Pigeon Point Dwarf Coyote Brush](#)

[Calandrinia maritima](#) Seaside Calandrina
