OptoGait

OptoGait is an innovative video gait analysis system and software package using high-resolution infrared technology. By timing the interruption of infrared beams being transmitted between two bars (from the transmitting TX bar to the receiving RX bar), OptoGait can give accurate data, allowing the practitioner to analyse gait using numerous measurements. In addition, the integrated video acquisition, using freely positioned cameras, provides moving images for further analysis.

During the execution of running, gait or a series of jumps tests, the contact and flight times can be measured with an accuracy of 1,000th of a second, and the position of the interrupted LEDs with a space resolution of 1cm. Starting from this basic data, the dedicated software measures in real-time a series of crucial data for movement analysis. The absence of mechanical moving parts ensures a long life, accuracy, and repetition possibilities.

OptoGait is portable, quick to set up, easy to use and can be used for the movement analysis and functional assessment of patients with normal or pathological conditions.



Gyko

Gyko is an inertial measurement tool for the analysis of the movement of any body segment. It contains the latest generation components that are used for making accurate and repeatable measurements of acceleration, angular velocity, and magnetic field in three dimensions.

- 3D accelerometer, to measure the linear accelerations to which the device is subjected (up to 16G).
- 3D gyroscope, to measure the angular velocities of the device (up to 2,000°/s with an
 acquisition frequency of 1000Hz.
- 3D magnetometer, to measure the magnetic field to which the device is subjected.

The Bluetooth data transmission provides real-time measurements directly to the PC via the Microgate software that, with its scientifically validated algorithms, offers simplified data processing and interpretation. Data can also be acquired without a PC, using a MicroSD memory card, thanks to its long lasting battery.

From the measured data, it is possible to describe the kinematics of the body segment to which Gyko is fastened so as to provide the user with summary information about the quality of the analysed movement.

Gyko can be used in two ways:

In combination with OptoGait Gyko acts as a optional accessory to your existing OptoGait equipment to provide additional data such as body sway and posture analysis during:

- Walking and running tests both on a treadmill and with one- or two-dimensional linear systems.
- Marching in place tests.
- Vertical jumping tests.
- The (new) tests for posture analysis.

Gyko, placed in the area beneath the shoulder blade by using a special bib with a comfortable 3-button fastening, enables integrating the information measured on the ground with the kinematics of the trunk in order to provide accurate information on the stability and coordination of the upper body.

The movement of the trunk is analysed in each phase of the step, and through advanced algorithms, specific parameters of the analysed test are estimated such as:

- Antero-posterior and medio-lateral imbalance.
- Main directions and breadth of the movement of the trunk.
- Dominant control strategy (AP, ML or neutral).

Advanced parameters such as the following are available:

- Upper Phase Coordination Index (UPCI) that describes coordination in the rotation of the trunk.
- Phase difference between the lower body and the upper body.
- RMS, harmonic ratio e-harmonicity index describing gait stability.

If you returned the Products to us because they were faulty or mis-described, please see clause 6.6.
- 6.6 We have the right to investigate claims for refund because products are returned to us as faulty or mis-described. 12.3 Subject to clause 12.2, we will under no circumstances whatever be liable to you, whether in Contract, tort (including negligence), breach of statutory duty, or otherwise, arising under or in connection with the Contract for:

- any loss of profits, sales, business, or revenue;
- loss or corruption of data, information or software;
- loss of business opportunity;
- loss of anticipated savings;
- loss of goodwill; or
- any indirect or consequential loss.

12.4 Subject to clause 12.2 and clause 12.3, our total liability to you in respect of all other losses arising under or in connection with the Contract, whether in Contract, tort (including negligence), breach of statutory duty, or otherwise, shall in no circumstances exceed the price of the Products

12.5 Except as expressly stated in these Terms, we do not give any representation, warranties or undertakings in relation to the Products. Any representation, condition or warranty which might be implied or incorporated into these Terms by statute, common law or otherwise is excluded to the fullest extent permitted by law. In particular, we will not be responsible for ensuring that the Products are suitable for your purposes.

13.2 We only supply the Products for domestic and private use. You agree not to use the product for any commercial, business or re-sale purposes, and we have no liability to you for any loss of profit, loss of business, business interruption, or loss of business opportunity.

13.3 We do not in any way exclude or limit our liability for:

- death or personal injury caused by our negligence;
- fraud or fraudulent misrepresentation;
- any breach of the Terms implied by section 12 of the Sale of Goods Act 1979 (title and quiet possession);
- any breach of the Terms implied by section 13 to 15 of the
- -Sale of Goods Act 1979 (description, satisfactory quality,
- fitness for purpose and samples); and defective products under -- the Consumer Protection Act 1987.

14. Force Majeure

14.1 Neither party shall be liable for any failure or delay in performing its obligations under the Contract to the extent that such failure or delay is caused by a Force Majeure event. A Force Majeure Event means any event beyond a party's reasonable control, which by its nature could not have been foreseen, or, if it could have been foreseen, was unavoidable, including strikes, lock-outs or other industrial disputes (whether involving its own workforce or a third party's), failure of energy sources or transport network, acts of god, war, terrorism, riot, civil commotion, interference by civil or military authorities, national or international calamity, armed conflict, malicious damage, breakdown of plant or machinery, nuclear, chemical or biological contamination, sonic boom, explosions, collapse of building structures, fires, floods, storms, earthquakes, loss at sea, epidemics or similar events, natural disasters or extreme adverse weather conditions or default of suppliers or subcontractors.

15. Other important terms

15.1 The Supplier may at any time assign, transfer, charge, subcontract or deal in any other manner with all or any of its rights or obligations under the Contract.

15.2 The Customer may not assign, transfer, charge, subcontract or deal in any other manner with all or any of its rights or obligations under the Contract without prior written consent of The Supplier.

15.3 If we fail to insist that you perform any of your obligations under these Terms, or if we do not enforce our rights against you, or if we delay in doing so, that will not mean that we have waived our rights against you and will not mean that you do not have to comply with those obligations. If we do waive a default by you, we will only do so in writing, and that will not mean that we will automatically waive any later default by you.

15.4 If you are a consumer, please note that these Terms are governed by English law. This means a Contract for the purchase of Products through our sites and any dispute or claim arising out of or in connection with it will be governed by English law. You and we both agree to that the courts of England and Wales will have non-exclusive jurisdiction. However, if you are a resident of Scotland, you may also bring proceedings in Scotland.
15.5 If you are a business, a Contract and any dispute or claim arising out of or in connection with it or its subject matter or formation (including non-contractual disputes or claims) shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the law of England and Wales.

15.6 If you are a business, we both irrevocably agree that the courts of England and Wales shall have exclusive jurisdiction to settle any dispute or claim arising out of or in connection with a Contract or its subject matter or formation (including non-contractual disputes or claims).
