Ecuador Southern Endemics *11th to 29th January 2022 (19 days)* Trip Report

Tour Summary

Due to incredibly complex geology and topography, southern Ecuador supports one of the most diverse habitat ranges in the world. Within 200 miles of the Pacific Coast, one can travel from the arid xerophytic habitat, through chocó and semi-deciduous tropical forest, over the continental divide's treeless páramos and down to the lush, wet, foothill forests of the eastern Andes. Within these varied pristine habitats, the evolution of many fine endemic species has occurred. The number of amazing birds that we saw was simply overwhelming, and the highlights of our epic trip are further narrated in this report.

Our Southern Ecuador adventure commenced with an early start out of Guayaquil. En route to El Cajas National Park, we made a tactical stop to search for the rare and local El Oro Tapaculo. After patiently waiting, we got to hear the distinct song of this species, but even after bushwhacking into a densely forested creek bed, we failed to get it in view. A Speckled Nightingale-Thrush was a welcome consolation though — what a stunner! Streak-headed Antbird, Golden-headed Quetzal, Slaty Antwren and Uniform Antshrike were among other goodies that we picked up in the early morning. We then continued our way up into the highlands where our first stop produced great views of the endemic Violet-throated Metaltail. Mouse-colored Thistletail was another target that showed nicely at this spot. The sought-after Giant Conebill took some effort but we eventually found an obliging family group in a *Polylepis* grove. Laguna Toreadora was fun with Tawny Antpittas hopping out in the open, and a cracking male Blue-mantled Thornbill. Tit-like Dacnis was also present, but this target was surprisingly skulking. At another nearby site, we upgraded our views of Tit-like Dacnis, including a superb adult male. Other targets that we added to the list included Paramo Ground Tyrant, Ecuadorian Hillstar and Andean Tit-Spinetail. At Laguna Llaviucu, we enjoyed scoping specialties like Andean Duck, Andean Coot, and Andean Gull. Without a doubt, Ecuadorian Rail was the highlight of the late afternoon, with a pair observed at close range!

The following morning, we did some garden birding with Green-tailed Trainbearer and Chiguancos Thrush before driving to Yunguilla. The hike into the reserve was birdy, with pygmy owl tape attracting smaller birds like a gorgeous male Purple-collared Woodstar, Pacific Elenia, Golden-rumped Euphonia, Tooth-billed Tanager and others, including the Pacific Pygmy Owl itself — simply fantastic! The endemic Pale-headed Brushfinch, our principal target for the day, was observed at three sites along the trail, and our last encounter was the best. This time, we all got perfect views of an adult brushfinch moving through the dry tangle right at eye level. Chestnut-crowned Antpitta was common by voice, and after some effort we did

see one shoot across the trail. For lunch, we enjoyed a delicious Ecuadorian ceviche, and for dinner we had a pretty exquisite eight course meal, with guinea pig for those that wanted to try this Ecuadorian delicacy.

Today we visited Cerro de Arcos, a remote peak in the highlands of Loja and El Oro provinces. It was a longish drive but we did pick up Streak-throated Bush Tyrant and a lovely pair of White-capped Dippers along the way. In the paramo, one of the first birds that we got was a cracking Jameson's Snipe that got flushed by Alan! At a patch of *Chuquiragua* scrub, we soon tracked down a male Blue-throated Hillstar, a Critically Endangered endemic, and our key target for the day. We watched the hillstar as it was foraging, but the male also perched very near us for close inspection — what an absolute gem! Other hummers that we got included the black-throated race *atrigularis* of Viridian Metaltail. Great Sapphirewing and Shining Sunbeams were also putting up a show at the refuge. A stroll through the grasslands produced another Jameson's Snipe, and finally also a couple of rather skulking Paramo Pipits. An interesting sighting in the area was a presumed intergrade between Mountain and Carunculated Caracara that we photographed. In the afternoon, we visited Huashapampa where some of us got brief flight views of Red-faced Parrot. The

parrots were quite vocal but never came back into view. Andean Pygmy Owl did cooperate, resulting in great scope views. The stunning Grey-breasted Mountain Toucan was also a welcome sighting. Smoky Bush Tyrant was picked up distantly at the clearing, together with other birds like Northern Mountain Cacique and Hooded Mountain Tanager. Just before dusk, we successfully targeted Equatorial Antpitta, a recent split from the former Rufous Antpitta complex.

The road up to Acacana was productive with our first stop yielding goodies like Bearded Guan, Black-capped Tyrannulet, Citrine Warbler, and a family flock of eight Orange-banded Flycatchers. A second *mega* flock contained prize birds like Black-headed Hemispingus, Plushcap, Golden-crowned Tanager, Agile Tit-Tyrant,


Pearled Treerunner, Grey-hooded Bush Tanager, Blue-backed Conebill, and many others — an amazing bird party indeed! We then searched hard for the rare Chestnut-bellied Cotinga at different locations but without success. However, Crescent-faced Antpitta, the top-notch bird of the area, was watched while it perched out in the open and singing — truly superb! In Loja town, we got Koepcke's Screech Owl at a day roost stake-out, a great sighting that we soon celebrated with some ice-cream.

Our morning walk along the Rio Bombuscaro trail started off with a bang: the endemic White-breasted Parakeet hanging inconspicuously on a clay wall, a flock of five birds just a few meters away from us!

Our next surprise was a showy Ecuadorian Piedtail, just around the corner. Amazonian Umbrellabird was only glimpsed by some as it flew off, and a singing Olive Finch remained super elusive. In contrast, the amazing Andean Cock-of-the rock showed nicely in a fruiting tree, both males and females. At the park headquarters, we did not get the hoped for umbrellabird but Foothill Elaenia was highly vocal, showing really well in a mixed-species flock. The scarce Fulvous-breasted Flatbill was a nice bonus in the same party of birds. A male Striolated Manakin was scoped and stayed long enough on its perch for everyone to get it — a real stunner! Further along the trail more species were added to the list including Common Scale-backed Antbird and Orange-crested Flycatcher. Other highlights today included several flocks of colorful tanagers, and many new hummingbirds at the flowers and feeders of Copalinga. In the afternoon, a flyover Amazonian Umbrellabird was called out by Alan, and picked up by the group — what a bonus! And, our luck continued, as we encountered a Grey Tinamou standing on the orange trail away from the known feeding site (the previous days it had not been seen at the corn feeder). A Blackish Nightjar was observed at dusk, but Band-bellied Owl did not show up.

We had to make an early start to get to the Zarza reserve but it was totally worth it. A cracking male Crested Quetzal was the very first bird that we got as we stepped out of the bus — bam! Yellow-throated Tanager at the same spot was also pretty sweet. Coppery-chested Jacamar played hard to get, and so did a Powerful Woodpecker that was knocking on a nearby tree. Higher up the reserve, on a stunted ridge, a splendid Bar-winged Wood Wren showed itself at close range. A side road did not produce the hoped for mixed-species flocks but we did flush a Blackish Nightjar from its day roost. Flock activity remained surprisingly slow, but we eventually connected nicely with both Spectacled Prickletail and Equatorial Greytail, sought-after specialties from this area. Coppery-chested Jacamar was a last-minute cracker that we got to see well. At lower elevations in the Nangaritzá valley, we added various species to our list including Olive-chested Flycatcher, Black-billed Seed Finch, and multiple Blackish Rails. After dinner, fellow birders showed us a magnificent Band-bellied Owl in the scope — an easy twitch!

The following morning, we kicked off with finding our main target, the Orange-throated Tanager! After seeing this rare and localized species really well, the pressure was off, but of course, we kept on birding. Bird activity was pumping with mixed-species flocks producing Speckled Spinetail, Slender-billed Xenops, Rufous-rumped and Rufous-tailed Foliage-gleaners, White-throated Woodpecker, Fulvous Shrike-Tanager, Wing-barred Piprites, Gilded Barbet, and many more! Purplish Jacamar was another desired target that we enjoyed, and Penny got us a rarity in the form of an adult Black-and-white Hawk-Eagle! At another spot, we watched a fantastic pair of Fiery-throated Fruiteaters. Unbelievably, good birds

just kept popping up with Yellow-cheeked Becard, Duida Woodcreeper, Red-billed Tyrannulet, and a Blackish Pewee, to name a few! Our hike up to the Tepui was intense but rewarding. We heard lots of new antbirds along the trail and managed to get good views of both Zimmer's and Spot-backed Antbird. Flock activity yielded several goodies including Wing-barred Piprites, White-bellied Pygmy Tyrant, Buff-throated and White-eyed Tody Tyrant. Grey-tailed Piha was another welcome addition. In the mystical stunted forest at the very top, we searched hard and eventually connected with the main prize bird: a male Royal Sunangel — what a cracker! Some more roadside birding in the morning yielded upgraded views of various species including White-bellied Pygmy Tyrant and an obliging male Black-and-white Tody-Flycatcher. A tactical lunch break on our way to Tapichalaca got us four new species of hummingbird including a crisp male Spangled Coquette — sweet! Ice-cream at the plaza of Vilcabamba was a delight, and an Elegant Crescentchest along the way was a bonus for some.

immature bird put up a show right in front of us! Along the trail we enjoyed Golden-plumed Parakeets once again, and a couple of Barred Fruiteaters were also a fine treat. Our drive to the Tumbesian dry forests was a long one, picking up a few good birds along the way, like Chestnut-collared Swallow, Tumbes Sparrow, and after dusk, a fantastic Spectacled Owl!


Our stay at Jorupe was wonderful. Birding from the breakfast table was fantastic with our first White-tailed Jays, Rufous-headed Chachalacas, Whooping Motmots and Guayaquil Squirrels, and Yellow-tailed and White-edged Orioles, among many other Tumbesian marvels. The morning walk was highly

At Tapichalaca, our first target after breakfast was Equatorial Antpitta, which showed up nicely at a worm feeder near the lodge. It was foggy and rainy along the infamous Jocotoco trail but we did get a few new birds including Black-throated Tody Tyrant and Rufous Spinetail. Golden-plumed Parakeets showed well at their nest boxes. The superstar, a Jocotoco Antpitta, came in for only a few seconds. It was a shy female, and the male named Pancho did not show up at all. Very likely for this reason a Chestnut-naped Antpitta came out for close viewing at the worm feeder — an unexpected bonus! Unfortunately, a few had missed the Jocotoco Antpitta so we waited for quite while at the feeder site, hoping for the bird to return. It kept raining in the afternoon, so we decided to travel down the valley to Valladolid in the hope for drier weather conditions. The plan worked out, with a gap of improved weather, and some good bird activity. Highlights included Maranon Thrush, Rufous-fronted Thornbird, and the scarce Highland Elenia. A small bush that was filled with colorful tanagers was a delight for our eyes, with Blue-necked, Silver-backed and Golden-eared Tanager all perched together! The follow morning, we tried again for the Jocotoco Antpitta, and with success, a fantastic

productive with outstanding views of many specialties including Ecuadorian Trogon, Slaty Becard, Grey-breasted Flycatcher, Blackish-headed Spinetail, Ecuadorian Piculet, and Speckle-breasted Wren. Even the elusive species like Watkins's Antpitta, Henna-hooded Foliage-gleaner, Elegant Crescentchest, and Pale-browed Tinamou were seen well! Our trip up to Utuana was a clean sweep as rarely one gets to see all the desired targets up there. Above Sozoranga we located Bay-crowned Brushfinches, among many other species. White-vented Plumeleteer of the race *intermedia* (a potential split as Ecuadorian Plumeleteer) was a bonus here too. Another stop produced Black-cowled Saltator, and moving through dense bamboo but showing well, the rare and tricky Grey-headed Antbird! Rusty-breasted Antpitta was a nice surprise at the reserve, and the hummingbird feeders got us fine gems such as Purple-throated Sunangel and Rainbow Starfrontlet. Jelski's Chat-Tyrant and Black-crested Tit-Tyrant were also targeted successfully. On our way back down, we gave it a final try, and suddenly the rare Piura Hemispingus popped up in a mixed-species flock! Our visit to the Zapotillo area was rewarding with great looks at the impressive Comb Ducks at arrival. Other lowland specialties that we enjoyed here included Tumbes Hummingbird, Tumbes Sparrow and Tumbes Tyrant.

The Buenaventura reserve was superb birding as usual. At the upper site, we successfully targeted the endemic El Oro Parakeet, where we enjoyed a family flock for a prolonged time at their nest box. The hummingbird feeders here were awesome, attended by Chocó gems such as Violet-tailed Sylph and Velvet-purple Coronet. We tried again for the El Oro Tapaculo, but only got to hear its contact call. Dusky Bush Tanagers of the race *xanthothorax* showed themselves nicely, a newly described subspecies with a distinct pale eye. In the lower part of the reserve, we spent significant time with a male Long-wattled Umbrellabird — a truly fantastic creature! Other highlights included a nest building Slaty-winged Foliage-gleaner, a rare species of which the nest was apparently unknown to science. The bird was excavating a cavity atop a broken-off tree trunk, and it did not pay much attention to our presence. A male White-throated Spadebill showing off its yellow coronal crest was a pretty neat observation too. After some efforts we connected nicely with Brownish Twistwing, and Ochraceous Attila was also tracked down successfully. La Tembladera wetlands were visited on our way to Guayaquil adding many fantastic birds to our list including Horned Screamer, Limpkin, Rufescent Tiger Heron, Grey-cheeked Parakeet, Masked Water Tyrant and Crimson-breasted Finch. A late afternoon hike at the edge of Manglares Churute reserve produced Grey-lined Hawk and Jet Antbird, among others.

Our last day of the tour was packed with excitement. The coastal scrub near Atahualpa produced many targets including Necklaced Spinetail, Grey-and-white Tyrannulet and Short-tailed Field Tyrant. It took us some effort to find the rare and erratic Sulphur-throated Finch, but eventually we found a massive flock

of this species, with 300 individuals likely being an underestimation — an incredible sighting! Coastal birding kicked off with Dale spotting a first-year Sabine's Gull circling above the beach, another unusual sighting. At the salt pans a dark-backed gull soon got our attention. It looked very much like a Kelp Gull, but something was not right. Luckily, a normal Kelp Gull landed next to the bird, so we were able to make direct comparisons, and photos. After careful study, it turned out to be a third-cycle Lesser Black-backed Gull in heavy molt — a first confirmed record for Ecuador! Another vagrant that flew in at this spot was a drake Northern Shoveler — crazy times! Apart from all these totally unexpected bird species, we enjoyed superb views of Chilean Flamingos foraging together with Roseate Spoonbills, a wide variety of boreal waders, and also resident shorebirds such as Snowy Plover and Grey-headed Gull. At the tip of La Chocolatera, we got close up flight views of Blue-footed Booby, one even showing its stunning blue feet — a great bird to end this epic trip with!
