Flannel Cudweed, Cotton Weed

Family

Asteraceae

Where found

Grassy areas and bare ground. Western Slopes.

Notes

Annual herb, **prostrate**, stemless, or stems to 10 cm long, **woolly**, grey-brown to grey-green. Leaves clustered at the base of the plant and **alternating** along the stems, 0.3-1.3 cm long, 1.5-5 mm wide, woolly, margins **entire**. Flower **heads** white or cream to yellow, about 5–10 mm high, 6–18 mm in diameter, **compound**, of 1–12 **partial heads**, each with with about 30–60 **florets**, 0 **petals**. Compound flower heads broad cylindrical to broad oval or broad cup-shaped, solitary.
