APRIL MEETING – REPORT BY BARB PYE

Neil Marriott, who is an authority on the genus Grevillea, gave us an interesting overview of what the botanists are deciding with regard to recognition of new species of Grevillea.

A few years ago, there was a push by some botanists to lump together Grevillea and Hakea, but fortunately for everyone interested in horticulture they will remain separate. An interesting question at the end of the talk was "What makes a grevillea a grevillea?" To separate a hakea from a grevillea, the simplest way is to look at the fruits. Hakeas have a woody nut while grevilleas have a leathery seed capsule.

There have been many new additions to the genus Grevillea in the past few years, and some old names have been reinstated. Despite there being few botanists researching the genus, there are now over 400 species, and a lot of potential species remain undescribed.

Some of the new additions since Marriott and Olde's 3 volume Grevillea Book produced in 1995 are *Grevillea nivea*, *Grevillea maccutcheonii* and *Grevillea rhyolitica*. *Grevillea victoriae* has been completely revised and divided into many new species.

We thank Neil for a very interesting and enjoyable talk.
